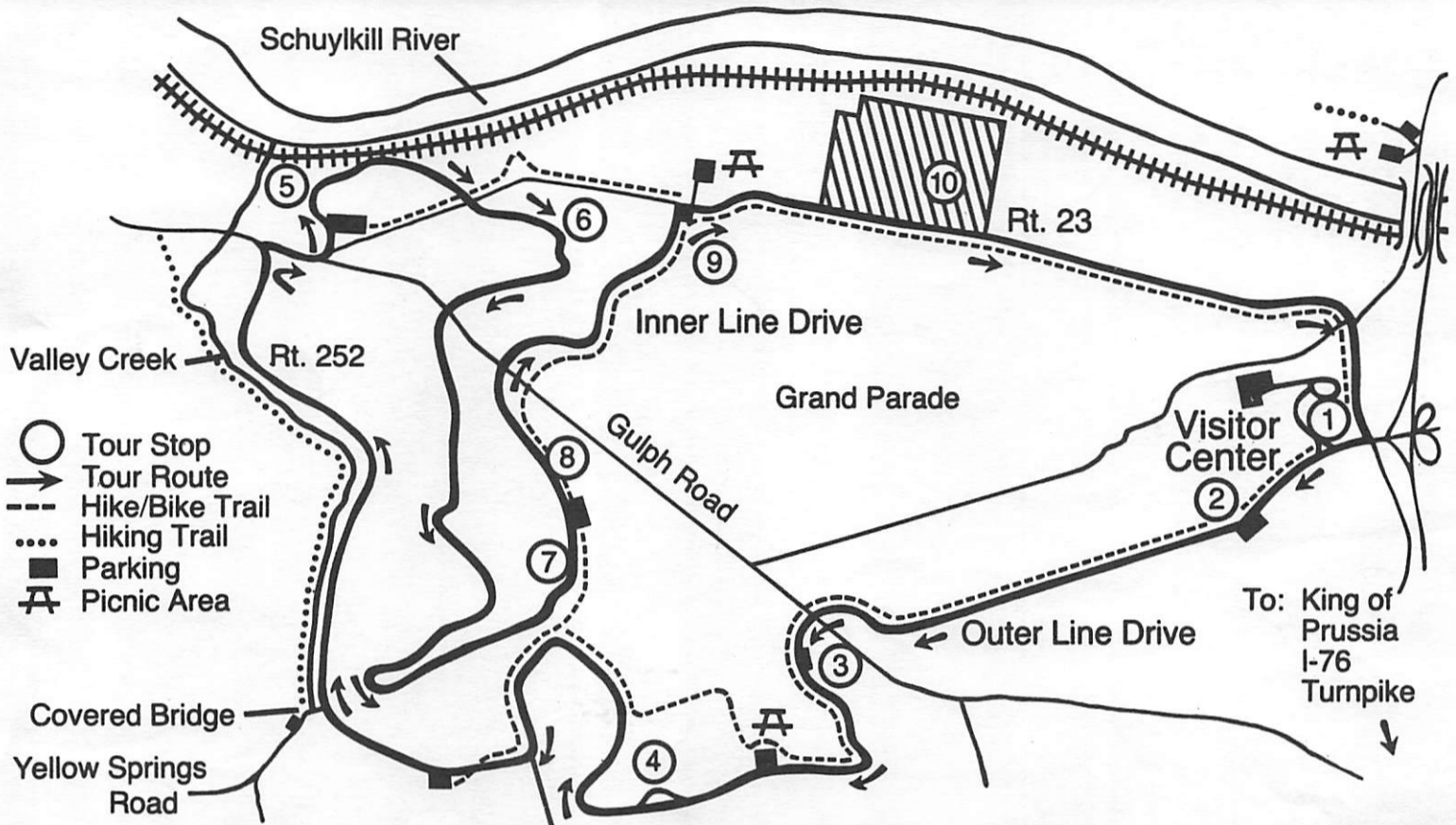


# Valley Forge

## TOURING VALLEY FORGE

**#1 VISITOR CENTER**  
Information, film every 30 minutes, museum, bookstore, restrooms. Seasonal: bus and audio tours, bicycle rentals. Open 8:30-5:00 daily.

**#2 MUHLENBERG BRIGADE**  
Reconstructed soldiers' huts on the site of Gen. Peter Muhlenberg's brigade. Staffed 10-4:30 weekends.

**#3 NATIONAL MEMORIAL ARCH**  
Monument dedicated to all those who served at Valley Forge.

**#4 ANTHONY WAYNE STATUE**  
Gen. Wayne's statue sits in the center of the area held by Pennsylvania troops under his command.

**#5 WASHINGTON'S HEADQUARTERS**  
Original house rented by Washington as quarters and work space for his staff and himself. Furnished. Open 8:30-5:00 daily. Food & souvenirs available.

**#6 REDOUBT #4**  
Earthen fort which anchored the north end of the inner defense line.

**#7 REDOUBT #3**  
Earthen fort which anchored the south end of the inner defense line.

**#8 ARTILLERY PARK**  
Central area for artillery under the command of Gen. Henry Knox.

**#9 VARNUM'S QUARTERS**  
Stephens farm house which served as temporary quarters for Gen. James Varnum of Rhode Island. Staffed 9:30-5:00 weekends.

**#10 WASHINGTON MEMORIAL CHAPEL & VALLEY FORGE HISTORICAL SOCIETY MUSEUM**

Located on private grounds within the park.

Chapel: Mon-Sat 8:00-5:00  
Sun 1:00-5:00

Museum: Mon-Sat 9:30-4:30  
Sun 1:00-4:30
