Milliken's Bend, June 7, 1863
Milliken's Bend helped to change
the belief that African Americans
couldn't fight in combat. After
demonstrating bravery in this battle,
over 185,000 more African Americans joined the Union Army between
1863 and 1865; participating in the
fight for freedom. The African American monument at Vicksburg honors
the black troops who fought there.
