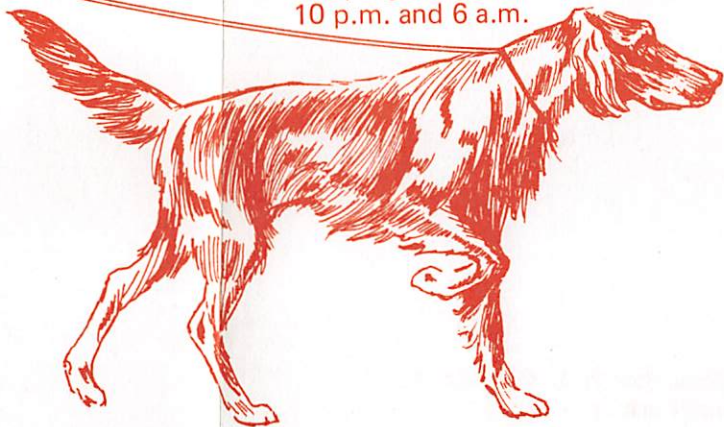

Dogs are permitted within public use areas, subject to the following conditions:

1. Your dog or other pets must be kept on a leash or other physical restrictive control, at all times. (Leash not to extend 8 feet in length.
2. Dogs and other pets are not permitted on designated swimming beaches.
3. Clean up and disposal of waste material deposited by dogs or other pets in all public use areas, is the responsibility of the owner.
4. Dog-gone silence shall be maintained in camping areas between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.



These measures must be taken to maintain public safety and sanitation standards due to the ever increasing number of dogs accompanying park visitors in the public use areas.

Furthermore...

Innocent persons have been injured by free roaming dogs. Barking dogs disturb the wildlife and campers. Dog waste is offensive to many people. It inconveniences and annoys other visitors using the area.
