WIND CAVE NATIONAL PARK: BLK MOUNTAIN CAMPGROUND REGULATIONS
NATIONAL PARKS BELONG TO EVERYONE. PLEASE HELP MAINTAIN A SAFE AND PLEASANT ENVIRONMENT BY
COMPLYING WITH THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. RECREATION FEES Campers are required to stop by the Campground office and follow the instructions at the fee station. \$7.00 per night/site. Golden Age/Golden Access passport holders: \$3.50 per night/site.
- 2. CAMPING Limit 14 days. Campground occupancy is on a first-come, first-serve basis. No Reservations. Do not leave your campsite unattended more than 24 hours.
- 3. CAMPSITES Camping and use of recreation vehicles is permitted only at established sites with designated parking. Each site is limited to a maximum of two vehicles and eight people in order to limit impact on the resources. Each site has one table to be left at site. Alteration of natural terrain by ditching or leveling of the ground is prohibited. Camping outside the designated campsite is not permitted. Handicapped sites available.
- 4. GROUP CAMPING There are no designated group campsites available. Educational/scientific groups may qualify for a camping fee waiver. A fee waiver must be requested prior to the groups arrival.
- 5. -CAMPGROUND HOST This person is located in Site #1 and is available to answer questions and provide assistance (May 15 Sept. 15).
- 6. SANITATION Campers are responsible for maintaining a clean campsite at all times. Remove all camping equipment, debris and refuse before leaving. Waste water must be collected and disposed of only at designated locations at restrooms. Cleaning fish, washing dishes or clothes, and bathing at water hydrants is not permitted. Sanitary dump stations are available in Hot Springs or Custer.
- 7. NATURAL RESOURCES Do not disturb plants, animals and other natural features in any way. Driving nails into, stripping bark, leaves or branches from trees or shrubs, disturbance of rock formations, and feeding or disturbing wildlife is prohibited.
- 8. FIREWOOD Firewood may be obtained from three established bins. Please take only what is needed for use at Wind Cave. Fires are permitted only in the fireplaces provided. Do not leave fires unattended. Wood and charcoal fires must be completely extinguished when leaving the site.
- 9. QUIET HOURS Quiet hours must be maintained between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. During these hours, radios and generators or other noise-producing devices must not be operated to the annoyance of others.
- 10. UTILITIES Individual water, sewage and/or electrical hookups from park utilities to camps are not permitted. Temporary hookups to fill water tanks are allowed.
- 11. PRTS All dogs, cats and other pets must be kept on leashes or under physical restraint at all times. Pets are not allowed in the backcountry.
- 12. FIREARMS Firearms, bows and arrows, sling shots, or similar weapons are not to be discharged within the park. Possession of such weapons is prohibited, unless they are unloaded and cased or packed so as to prevent use in the park. Fireworks are prohibited in the park.
- 13. PROTECT YOUR VALUABLES Help reduce the possibility of theft by keeping all valuables with you at all times. Lock your vehicle. Report suspicious activity to a Ranger immediately.
