Built in 1843, the Wesleyan Chapel was the meeting place for the First Women's Rights Convention held in 1848 in Seneca Falls, New York. The men and women in this convention adopted the Declaration of Sentiments, which declared 16 goals of equality for women including rights to vote and own property.
