## How and when can I make a campsite reservation?

Campgrounds requiring reservations are usually full from around April through September. You should make a reservation as early as possible or arrive early in the morning to secure a first-come, first-served site in one of the non-reserveable campgrounds outside Yosemite Valley.

## Additional information

- Showers are only available at Half Dome Village (formerly Curry Village) year round, Housekeeping Camp in the summer, and at Tuolumne Meadows Lodge during limited afternoon hours in the summer. Laundry facilities are available at Housekeeping Camp in Yosemite Valley year round (\$).
- Dump stations are available at Upper Pines (year round), near Wawona (summer) and Tuolumne Meadows (summer). There are no hook-ups in any Yosemite campgrounds.
- Flush toilets are only available in campgrounds that have tap water; all others have vault toilets.
- Group campsites are available by advanced reservation only at Wawona (year round) and during the summer only at Hodgdon Meadow, Bridalveil Creek, and Tuolumne Meadows.

## Regulations

- You must store food and scented items in provided food storage lockers 24 hours per day. Lockers measure 45"wide, 18"tall and 33"deep. No food storage is allowed in vehicles. Help us keep bears wild.
- Camping or sleeping in vehicles is permitted only in designated campsites.
- There is a maximum of 6 people (including children) and 2 vehicles per campsite.
- The camping limit in Yosemite in a calendar year is 30 days; however, May 1 thru Sept. 15, the limit in Yosemite is 14 days, and only 7 of those days can be in Yosemite Valley or Wawona.
- Check-out time for all campsites is at noon.
- · Pets must be on a leash and can not be left unattended and tied to an object.
- Firewood may not be collected in Yosemite Valley; in campgrounds outside of the Valley only dead and downed wood may be collected for fires. Campfires are permitted year round. However, May 1 thru Oct. 15 fires are only permitted between 5 p.m. to 10 p.m. in Yosemite Valley.
- Generators may be used 7am-9am, 12pm-2pm, and 5pm-7pm. Electrical extension cords may not be connected to restroom outlets.
- Camp wastewater must be disposed of in designated utility drains.
- Sewage must be disposed of at designated dump stations (Yosemite Valley, Wawona, and Tuolumne Meadows).
- Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.
