DESCRIPTION OF THE CABIN AND OF LOGS OF EXTERIOR AND INTERIOR APPEARANCE

The McCauley cabin is a one-story, simple in structure, measuring 18 ft. x 22 ft. The roof is made of cedar shingles and has been on the interior to last for well over 10 years. The logs are laid in alternating rows and notched for each of the corners at a 45-degree angle. The logs were chinked with a mix of sand and cement. The exterior chinking has been covered with a layer of cement. There is a small door opening on the east side, and a board and batten door with a 1/2" netting. On each end (S. and N.) of the cabin there is a small opening within with exterior board siding.

The interior is pine-planked. There are 3 logs round logs running between the poles of logs which support the roof. Attention is given to a wood outside the roof and a concrete floor. Concrete was also poured into trench around the exterior logs of the cabin.
