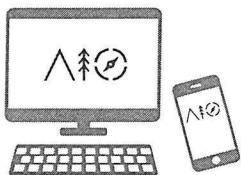

You can apply for a permit before your trip on [www.recreation.gov](http://www.recreation.gov). Find the date you plan to be in Zion and apply.

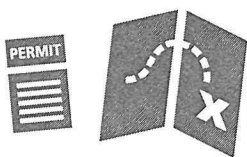
## Seasonal Lottery

There are four seasonal lotteries throughout the year: Spring, Summer, Fall, and Winter.

## Day-before Lottery

You can apply for a permit the day before your planned hike. This lottery opens every day at 12:01 a.m. and closes at 3 p.m. Mountain Time (MT). At 4 p.m. on the day you apply, you will receive an email to let you know the outcome.



**Print or download your confirmation email before arriving at the trailhead. Bring your ID!**

Cell service and internet connection are limited in Zion Canyon. You will need to present your permit to a ranger in order to complete your hike, so plan accordingly.

*Receiving a permit grants you access to Angels Landing, but does not give you privileged access to the Zion Canyon Shuttle or Scenic Drive.*

## Application Fee

There is a \$6 application fee for permits. This fee covers an application for up to 6 people. This fee is non-refundable.

## Permit Fee

If you receive a permit, you will be charged \$3 per person. You may cancel until two days before the reservation date for a full refund.
