There are about 300 parking spaces in Zion Canyon. When parking is full, the National Park Service actively manages access to Zion Canyon Scenic Drive until spaces are available.

PARKING ALERTS

Zion posts an alert online when parking is unavailable. The alert disappears when parking is available. Check online before driving to Canyon Junction.

- Hike Pa'rus and Watchman Trails near the Zion Canyon Visitor Center.
- Attend a free ranger program at the Zion Canyon Visitor Center.
