The light at Piedras Blancas was first illuminated in 1875. The lighthouse originally stood 100 feet in height. Presently the light station, including the lighthouse, is being restored to its original appearance.

Piedras Blancas Light Station is located six miles north of Hearst Castle at San Simeon California, along scenic Highway One.



Piedras Blancas Light Station Tours

From September 1 - June 14 tours are offered
Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays.

From June 15 - August 31 tours are offered
Mondays through Saturdays. *There are no tours
on federal holidays.* Tours last about 2 hours and
include the historic lighthouse, support buildings,
wildlife viewing and spectacular scenery along an
easy 1/2 mile interpretive trail. Wear comfortable
walking shoes and dress warmly. No pets!

located 1.5 miles north of the
light station at 9:45 a.m.

Do not wait at the gate to the lighthouse!
