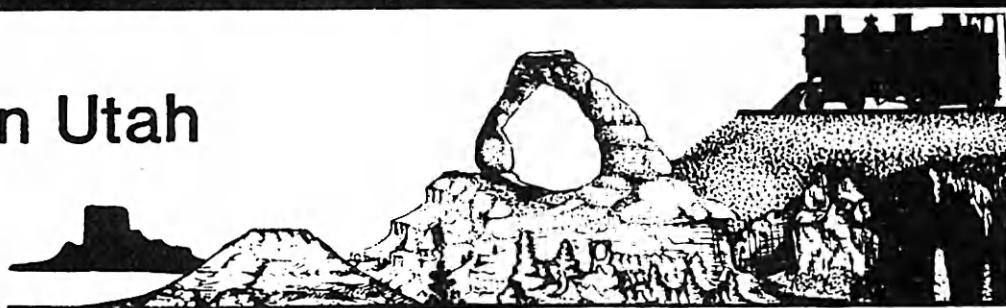

ARCHES

OPEN YEAR ROUND \$3/vehicle or \$1/person
entrance fee. Camping fee is \$7/site.

Extraordinary products of erosion in the form of giant arches, windows, pinnacles, and pedestals change color constantly as the sun moves overhead.

BRYCE CANYON

OPEN YEAR ROUND \$5/vehicle or \$2/person entrance fee. Camping fee is \$6/site. Lodging rates vary.

Along the edge of the Paunsaugunt Plateau in southern Utah stand many highly colored and bizarre pinnacles, walls, and spires, perhaps the most colorful and unusual eroded forms in the world.

CANYONLANDS

OPEN YEAR ROUND \$3/vehicle or \$1/person
entrance fee. Camping fee is \$6/site.

In this geological wonderland, rocks, spires, and mesas rise more than 7,800 feet. Here, too, are petroglyphs left by the Indians about 1,000 years ago.

CAPITOL REEF

OPEN YEAR ROUND \$3/vehicle or \$1/person
entrance fee. Camping fee is \$6/site.

Narrow high-walled gorges cut through a 60-mile uplift of sandstone cliffs with highly colored sedimentary formations.

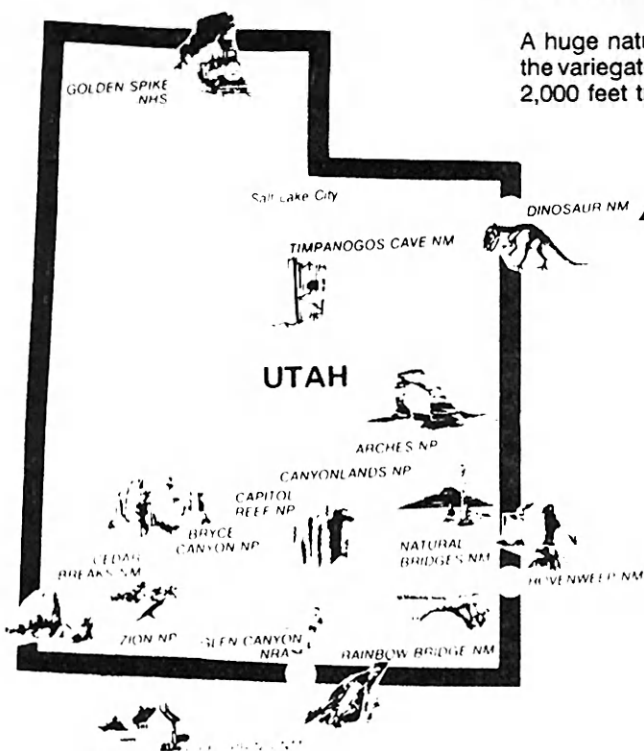


CEDAR BREAKS

CLOSED IN WINTER. \$3/vehicle or \$1/person entrance fee. Camping fee is \$6/site.

A huge natural amphitheater has eroded into the variegated Pink Cliffs (Wasatch Formation), 2,000 feet thick at this point.

DINOSAUR

OPEN YEAR ROUND \$5/vehicle or \$2/person
entrance fee. Camping fee is \$6/site.

Spectacular canyons were cut by the Green and Yampa Rivers through upfolded mountains. A quarry contains fossil remains of dinosaurs.
