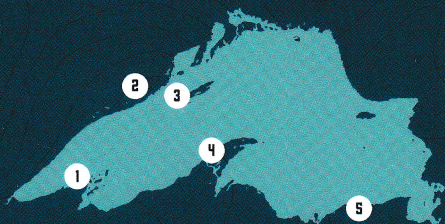
The mission of NPLSF is to preserve the natural resources and cultural heritage of all five national parks along Lake Superior.
