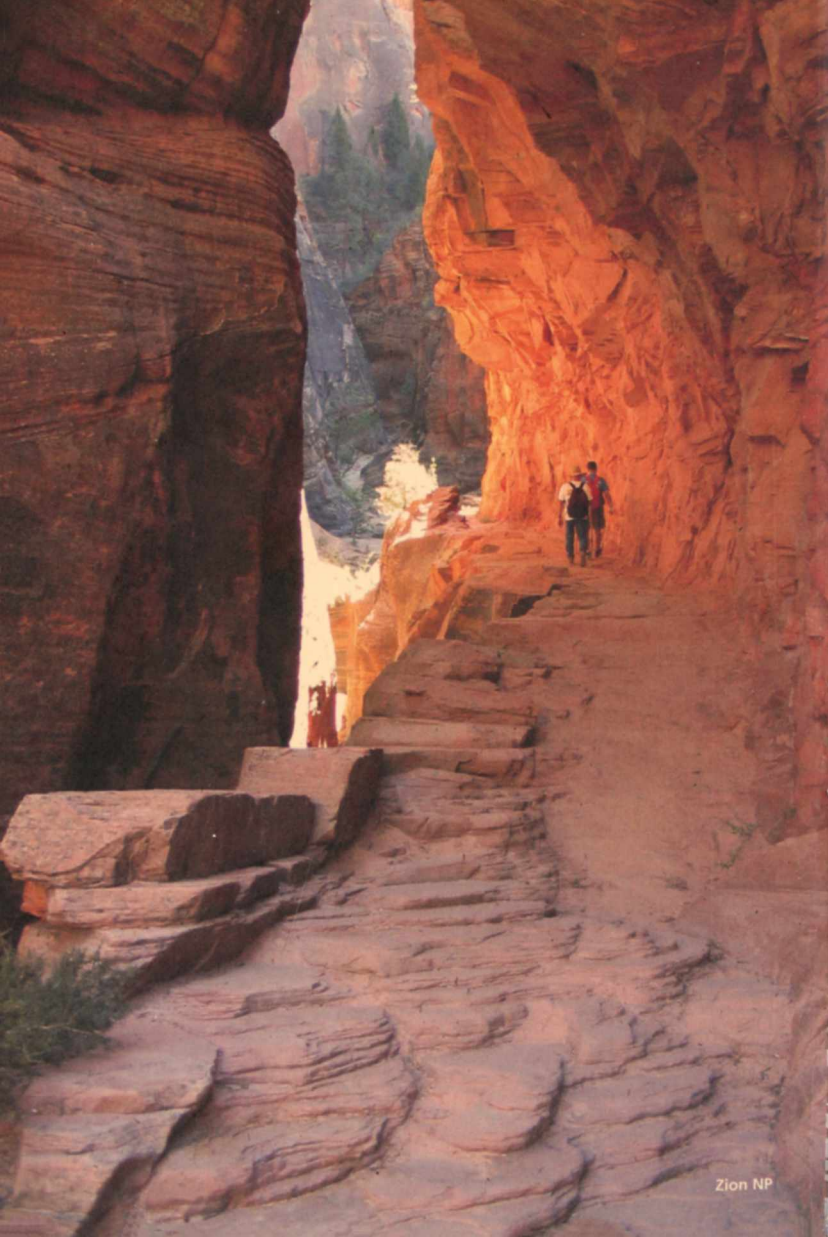

Wherever your National Parks Pass takes you, National Park Rangers, volunteers and other staff members will always be there to help make sure your visit is a memorable one. Nothing brings us more satisfaction than caring for these National treasures on behalf of the American people, so your family and generations to come can enjoy them. So pack up your National Parks Pass and Owner's Manual and get ready to Experience Your America!

Your National Parks Pass

The National Parks Pass is your official entry pass to enjoying America's National Parks—places like Yosemite, Carlsbad Caverns and the Statue of Liberty, as well as hundreds of other Parks, historic sites, battlefields, recreation areas, and seashores across America. There are nearly 400 places in all to choose from!

The 2004 National Parks Pass is valid for admission at all National Parks that charge an entrance fee. The National Parks Pass does not cover fees for certain guided tours of historic homes or caves, parking or camping fees. In addition, many Parks do not charge admission. For more information about fees at the National Park you will be visiting, check www.nps.gov.

The National Parks Pass is not transferable. Lost or stolen National Parks Passes cannot be replaced. A valid photo ID is required when presenting the National Parks Pass. The National Parks Pass is valid for one full year from first use in a National Park or through December of the following year, whichever comes first.

Important Notes



When you see the Parks Pass icon in this Owner's Manual, it indicates that the Park requires an entry fee and that your Pass will provide admission in lieu of this fee.

When you see the (HQ) abbreviation in this Owner's Manual, it indicates that the city listing corresponds with a separate headquarters office for the Park. It is not a geographic reference point. For example, the city listing for Saint Croix Island IHS in Maine (Map 1) is Bar Harbor, which refers to the HQ office in Acadia National Park. Therefore, Acadia would be the primary point of contact for information on Saint Croix Island IHS.

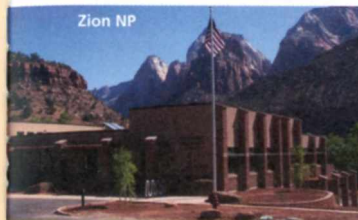
Your Fees at Work

The National Parks Pass is an important source of funds for Parks around the country. More than 80% of proceeds go directly into vital Park programs. For a perfect example of how the Parks Pass program made a difference, you need look no further than Zion National Park.

Beginning in 1989, Park Rangers at Zion began discussing the need for an Emergency Operations Center (EOC). The facility was needed to house all of the parks' emergency vehicles and personnel. With the help of the National Parks Pass program, Zion's dream of an EOC became a reality in 2004. Of the \$3.5 million that went into the project, 73% was funded by Parks Pass funds!

On top of meeting the needs of the Park and being a state-of-the-art facility, the EOC is environmentally friendly. In building the facility, the builders used recycled materials, installed solar tubing for its lighting system, and used a drip irrigation system for water conservation. The result is a facility that qualifies for a Silver LEED designation by the U.S. Green Building Council, an accomplishment that proves that Zion's EOC is one of the most sustainable facilities in any of America's National Parks.

Calling all Kids

National Parks are America's biggest classrooms! They provide places to learn about history, culture, and nature. Park Rangers take care of our Parks and let us know what there is to see and do. Through the Junior Ranger program, kids can become Junior Rangers themselves. There's a lot to learn about in our parks—from Joshua Tree National Park where kids become biologists exploring how plants and animals adapted to survive in a desert ecosystem to becoming a geo-detective investigating where dinosaurs may have roamed in Bryce Canyon National Park. Kids will be officially sworn in as Junior Rangers and presented with certificates and badges after completing the program activities. There are over 286 National Parks that offer Junior Ranger programs, so be sure to keep that in mind when planning your next Park trip.

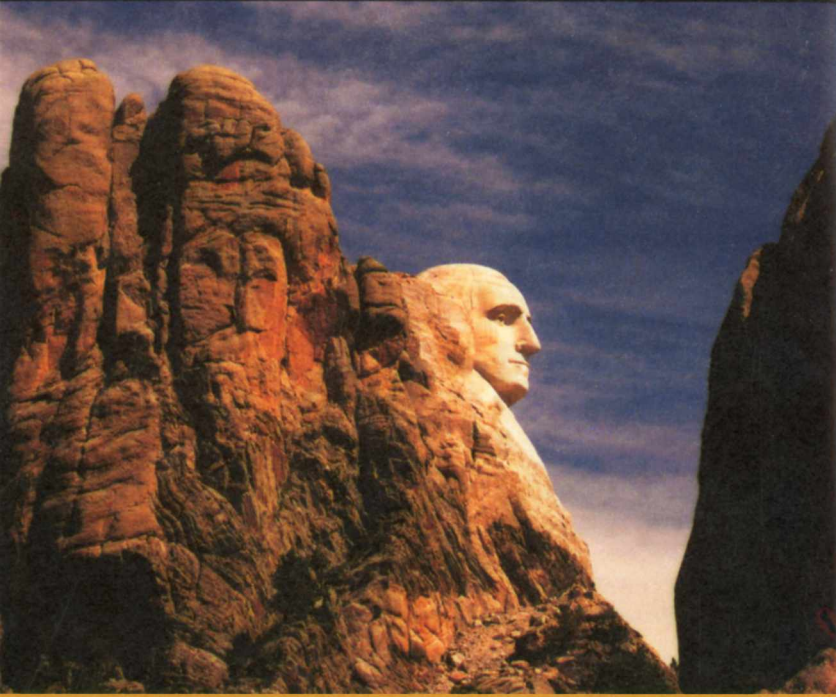

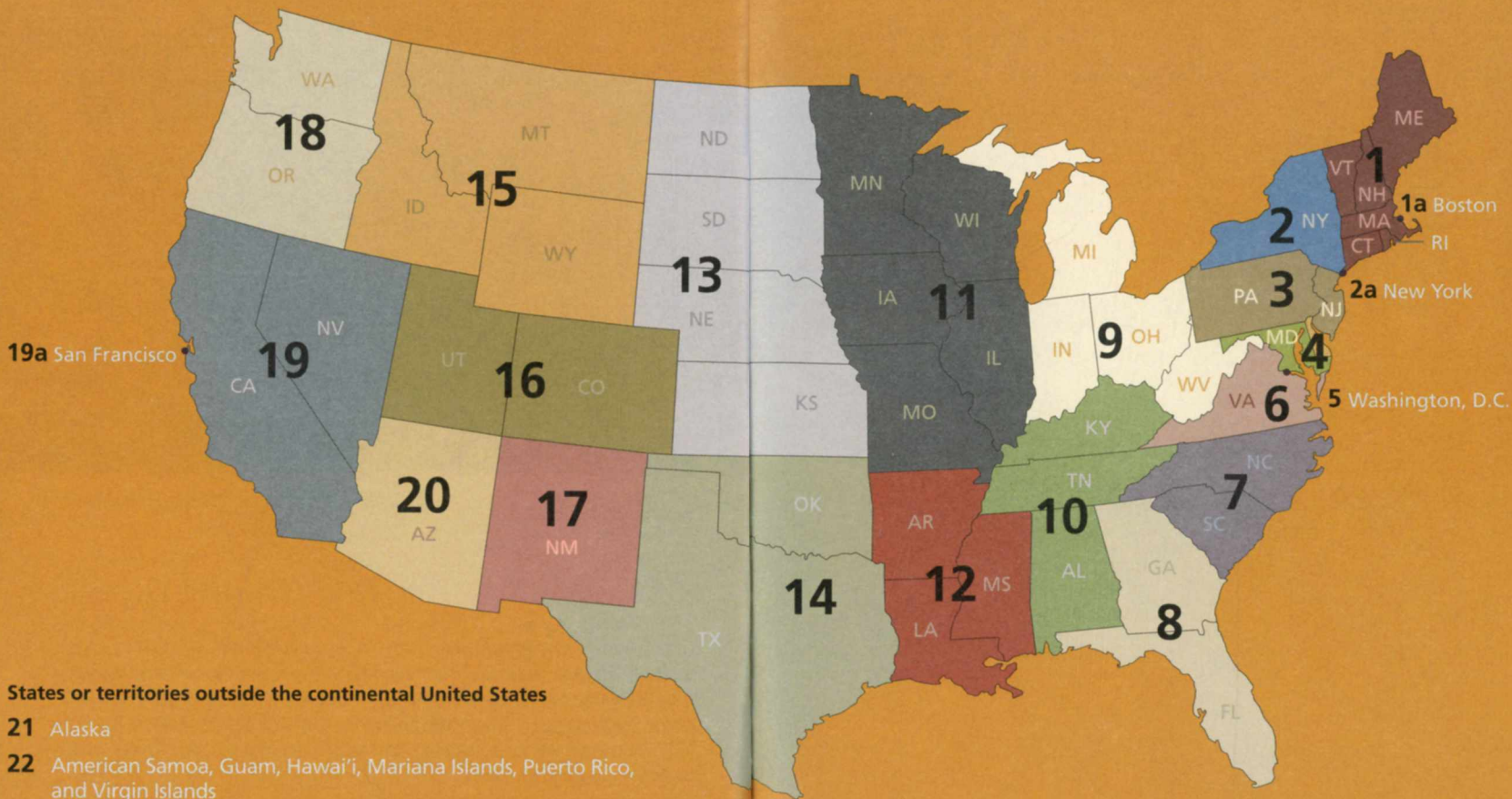

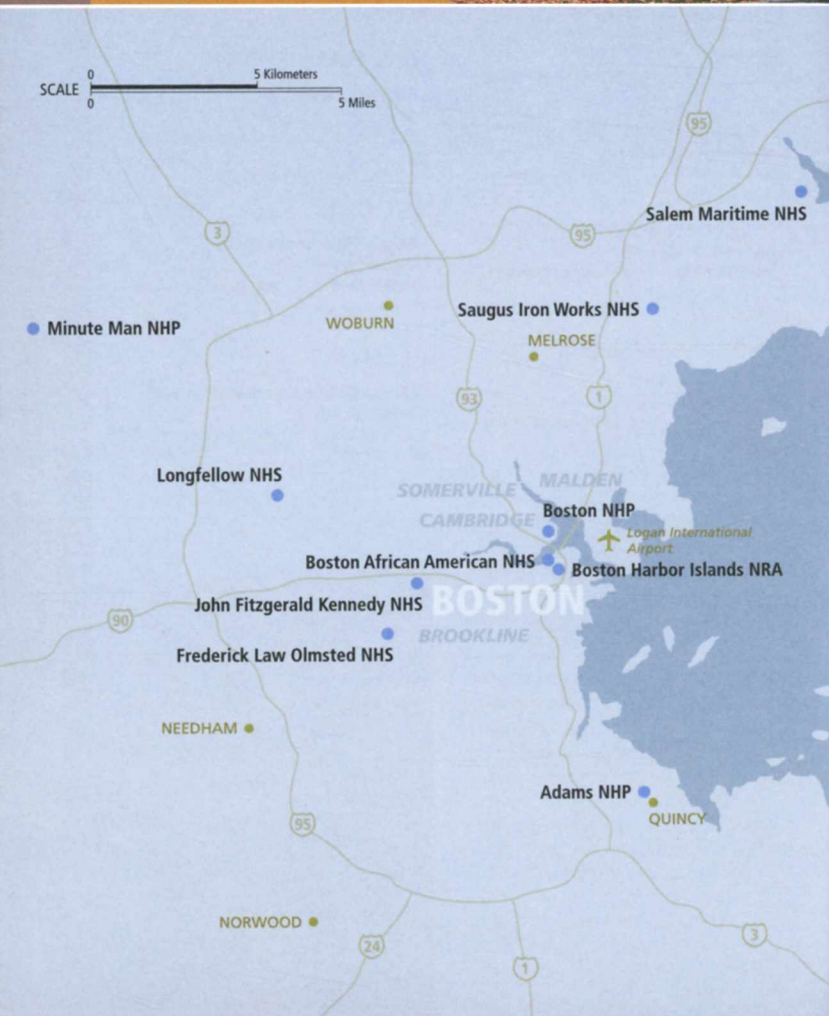

What will you see? Taking a trip to Boston can really get the patriotic spirit going, as the city and its surrounding areas played a significant role in the American Revolution. Start your journey by walking **Boston National Historical Park's** Freedom Trail — a 3 mile walking tour that highlights some of Boston's most historically relevant sites, such as the Paul Revere House, the Bunker Hill Monument, Faneuil Hall and the USS Constitution. To enhance your experience while visiting Boston, check out Discovery Channel's new ParkDoc, ***A Revolutionary Idea***, that is now playing at numerous National Park Service sites in the Boston area. The documentary provides plenty of historical information for the Boston area and is sure to give you ideas of other places to visit!

What will you see? Take a trip to Hyde Park to learn more about one of the United States' most recognized political families, the Roosevelts. At the **Home of Franklin D. Roosevelt National Historic Site**, see the only four-term President's famous birthplace and home, as well as visit the FDR Presidential Library and Museum dedicated to his work as the nation's commander-in-chief. And don't miss the Presidential gravesite located in the beautiful Rose Garden on the estate grounds. Nearby in Hyde Park, visit the **Eleanor Roosevelt National Historic Site**, the first National Historic Site dedicated to a First Lady. If you have the time, venture west to **Theodore Roosevelt Inaugural National Historic Site**, to see where "Teddy" was sworn into office as the 26th President of the United States.

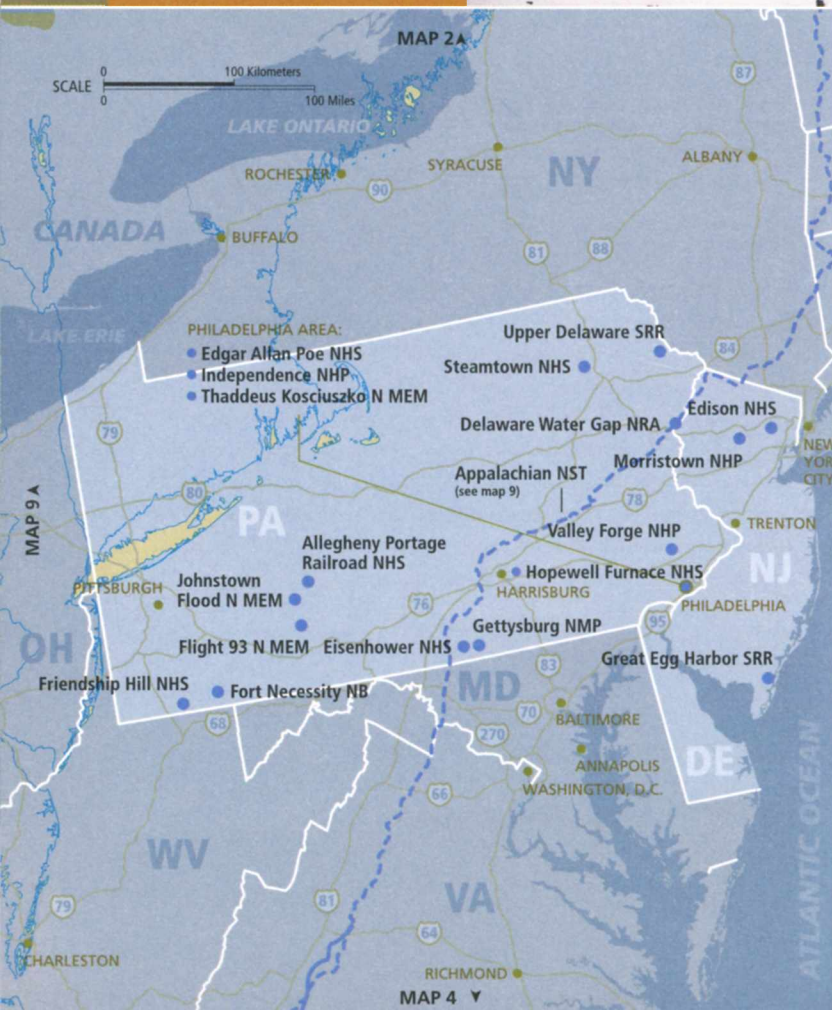

What will you see? Hopewell Furnace National Historic Site preserves an iron plantation that operated from 1771-1883. Hopewell Furnace made cannon and shot used in the Revolutionary War and products — such as cast-iron stoves — that brought improvements to the everyday lives of average Americans. Special events and living history programs include demonstrations of molding and casting, cooking, and sheep shearing.

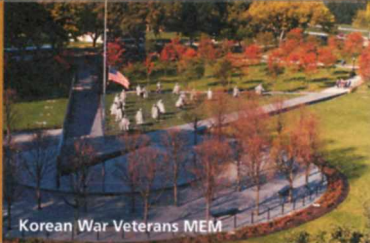

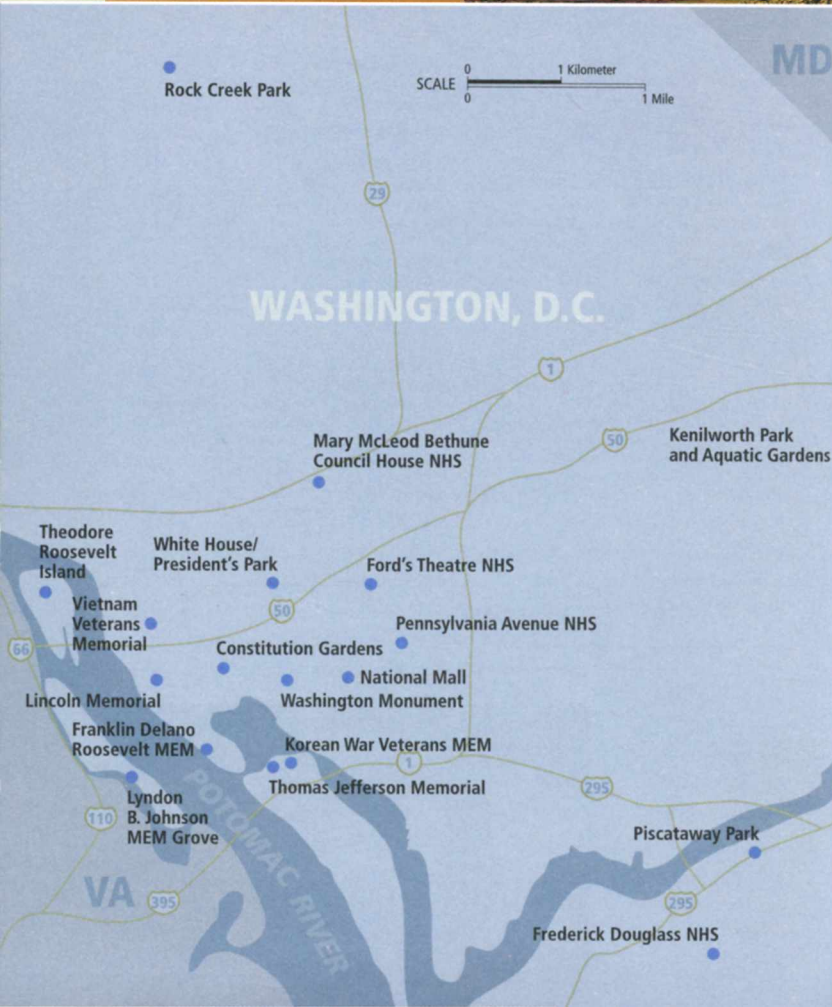
What will you see? Fort McHenry NM and Historic Shrine is world-famous as the birthplace of the American National Anthem. As the guardian of Baltimore's harbor, the valiant defense of Fort McHenry by American forces during a British attack on September 13–14, 1814 inspired 35-year old poet-lawyer Francis Scott Key to write "The Star-Spangled Banner." Following the Battle of Baltimore during the War of 1812, the fort never again came under attack. However, it remained an active military post off and on for the next 100 years. Of all the areas in the National Park System, Fort McHenry is the only one designated a national monument and historic shrine.

What will you see? Take a step back in time at **Colonial National Historical Park**, home to Jamestown, the oldest permanent English settlement in North America, and Yorktown, site of the last major battle of the Revolutionary War in 1781. The beautiful Colonial Parkway connects these historic sites with Colonial Williamsburg and offers spectacular views of the James and York rivers, along with abundant wildlife, including osprey and bald eagles. Special activities at Jamestown include the glassblowing demonstrations at the Glasshouse and the archeological excavations which are uncovering the foundations of America. Visitors to Yorktown can view the recently restored tents used by General Washington during the war and visit the homes of colonial patriots, including Thomas Nelson, Jr., a signer of the Declaration of Independence. Experience the sense of place that formed the character of a nation in the 17th and 18th centuries.

What will you see? If you're not an Astronaut, **Craters of the Moon National Monument and Preserve** is probably the closest experience you will have to walking on the moon. In fact, astronauts Alan Shepard, Joe Engle, Eugene Cernan and Edgar Mitchell visited here in 1969 before going to the moon. The area's unique, moon-like surface is actually a result of three major lava fields covering nearly 500,000 acres. This creates a bizarre surface that, for the most part, is undeveloped and is the largest young basaltic lava field in the lower 48 states.

Notable National Park Happenings in 2005

The 25th annual Traditional Native American Trade Festival

Point Reyes National Seashore will play host to the 25th annual Traditional Native American Trade Festival on July 16, 2005. Visitors can expect ancient skills demonstrations along with traditional food booths and arts and crafts for sale.

Roosevelt's Inaugural Ball Centennial . . . 1905-2005

In March 1905, a lavish inaugural ball was held in President Teddy Roosevelt's honor in Washington, D.C. To celebrate the centennial anniversary of this event, the **Theodore Roosevelt Inaugural National Historic Site** in Buffalo, NY will host a night of festivities March 5, 2005 which will include a sumptuous dinner, dancing, and several special "presidential" surprises.

Andersonville Revisited Living History Weekend

From March 12 to March 13, 2005, visit the bygone ages of **Andersonville National Historical Site** as living history interpreters will portray Union prisoners and Confederate guards, providing a full Civil War environment. To totally immerse visitors in the experience, individuals will have the ability to witness daily life in the camp including the arrival of prisoners, rations issues, guard drills, and artillery demonstrations. On Saturday evening, candle lantern tours of the prison site will be provided by reservation.

229th Anniversary of the Battle of Moores Creek Bridge

At the 229th anniversary of the 1776 Patriot victory, **Moores Creek National Battlefield** will host a variety of events on February 26-27, 2005 to commemorate the battle. Patriot and Loyalist militia re-enactors will demonstrate military camp life including weapons firing (musket, artillery and broadsword), as well as other 18th century skills. Filming for a new park movie will be taking place, providing a unique opportunity to watch rehearsals.

The 190th anniversary of the Battle of New Orleans

2005 marks the 190th anniversary of the Battle of New Orleans. From January 6-8, 2005, Chalmette Battlefield, one of the six sites of **Jean Lafitte National Historical Park and Preserve**, will commemorate the last major battle of the War of 1812 with military drills, cannon and musket firings, demonstrations, and activities. Park staff and volunteers in period clothing will represent American and British soldiers and civilians, taking visitors 190 years into the past as both sides prepare for battle.

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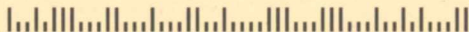
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
