A US flag flew high above Fort Larned, whose location along the Santa Fe Trail brought many cultures together. White and Hispanic traders could resupply at the post sutler's store while African American "Buffalo Soldiers" provided protection. As an Indian agency, the fort distributed food and annuities to the American Indians.
