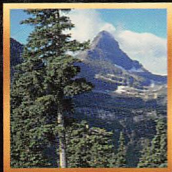

GLACIER NATIONAL PARK

WEST GLACIER, MONTANA

While there are about 50 small glaciers in Glacier National Park, its name is a tribute to the massive glaciers of the last ice age. The dramatic scenery, including forests, wildflower meadows, 200-plus lakes and spectacular mountains, was created over 3 million years as glaciers repeatedly covered the land and then retreated.

Besides its natural beauty, another park attraction is the 52-mile-long Going to the Sun Road which winds past valleys and waterfalls before reaching Logan Pass some 6,600 feet above sea level.
