## LOWELL NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK

MASSACHUSETTS

Lowell National Historical Park pays tribute to the American Industrial Revolution, namely New England's evolution from simple farming to manufacturing and technology-centered industry.

Highlights of the park include the Visitor Center, the "Working People Exhibit," housed in a restored mill girl boardinghouse, and the Boott Cotton Mills Museum with its operating weave room exhibit of 88 power looms.

Guided tours of the industrial city by boat and turn-of-the-century trolley are available (July-September). Walking tours are offered year round.

### SPECIAL INFORMATION

The park has available tactile pedestrian maps, braille and larger print material, and cassette tapes for the sight-impaired. The Visitor Center, Mogan Cultural Center and Boott Cotton Mills Museum are handicapped accessible.
