

U.S.S. ARIZONA



The USS Arizona Memorial honors the servicemen who lost their lives during the December 7, 1941 Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor. The Memorial straddles the full of the sunken battleship U.S.S. Arizona which contains the remains of many of the 1,177 crewman who died that day.

Ranger talks, film presentation, and shuttle boat tours to and from the Memorial are free of charge, The USS Arizona Memorial visitor center is adjoined by the World War II Fleet Submarine Museum and the U.S.S. Bowfin.
