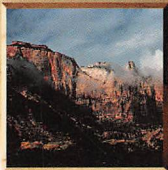

The highlight of the national park is Zion Canyon, a brilliantly colored sandstone spectacle with cliffs up to 3,000 feet high. For the last 13 million years, the force behind the ever-changing canyon has been the Virgin River which flows between the steep canyon walls.

Beyond Zion Canyon the park is noted for its remarkable collection of natural arches. Among them is the world's largest free-standing arch know as Kolob Arch, with a span of 310 feet. Other rock formations to see are: Towers of the Virgin, Angels Landing, and Weeping Rock.

### **SPECIAL INFORMATION**
