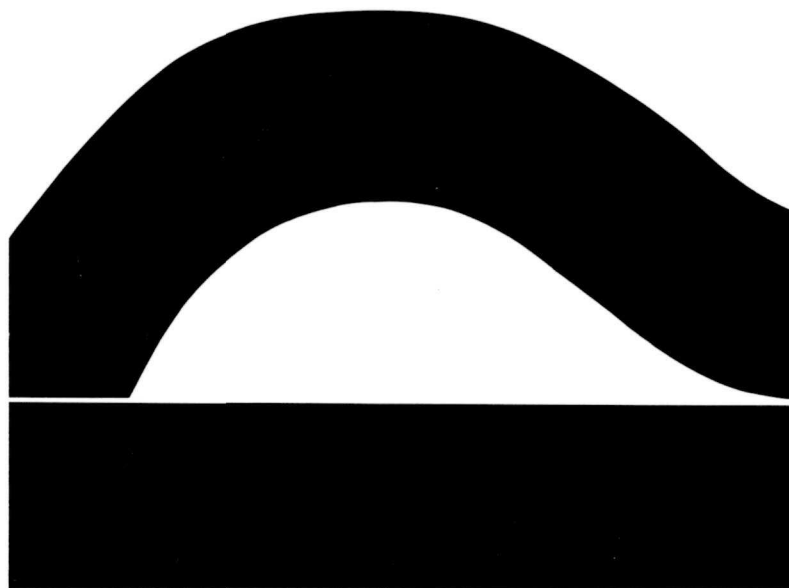




Park Practice Index 1974

Park Practice Index 1974

This is the 1974 index of all the publications of the Park Practice Program. It has two parts: a functional section and a subject section. The functional index lists all the entries under their appropriate functions: Administration, Design and Development, Enforcement, Interpretation, Maintenance, Planning, Safety, or Visitor Protection and Service. This was designed for the person who is seeking all the available information pertaining to a particular function. The subject index is simply an alphabetical listing of all the entries.

The abbreviations are GR for GRIST, GU for GUIDELINE, TR for TRENDS, and DE for DESIGN. The entries from GRIST and GUIDELINE are followed by the volume, number, and page where they can be found. The entries from TRENDS are followed by letters which represent the months of the issues, the year and page numbers. The entries from DESIGN are followed by a code letter and a four digit number indicating the particular section and position in the DESIGN book.
