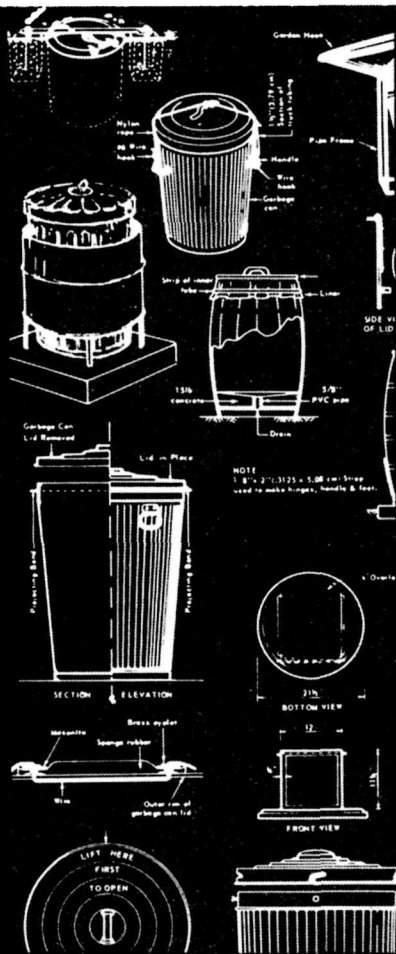

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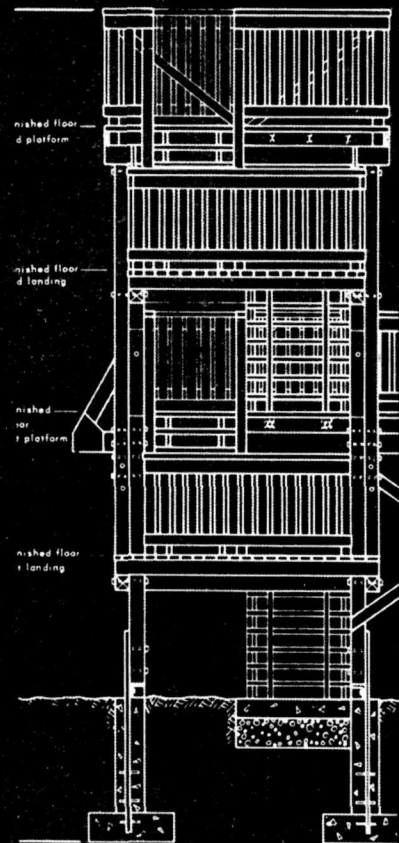
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Trends



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About the Index. . .

All articles published in **TRENDS**, **GRIST** and **DESIGN** during the 1982 calendar year are included in this cross-referenced index. The index is divided into two sections. The first section identifies the various subjects that appear in the publications. The second section lists the persons or organizations that have contributed articles, ideas or designs to the program along with the subject areas that these items address.

DE:	Design
Page	The specific page on which the topic appeared in either Grist or Trends is indicated. For Design entries, the number refers to the index number for each design.

Contributor: The person or organization that wrote or contributed the published item.

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The Park Practice Program includes: *Trends*, a quarterly publication on topics of general interest in park and recreation management and programming; *Grist*, a quarterly publication on practical solutions to everyday problems in park and recreation operations including energy conservation, cost reduction, safety, maintenance, and designs for small structures; *Design*, a quarterly compendium of plans for park and recreation structures which demonstrate quality design and intelligent use of materials.

Membership in the Park Practice Program includes a subscription to all three publications and a library of back issues arranged in binders with indices, and all publications for the remainder of the calendar year.

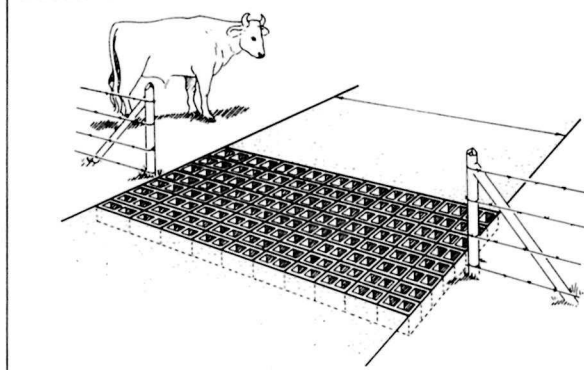

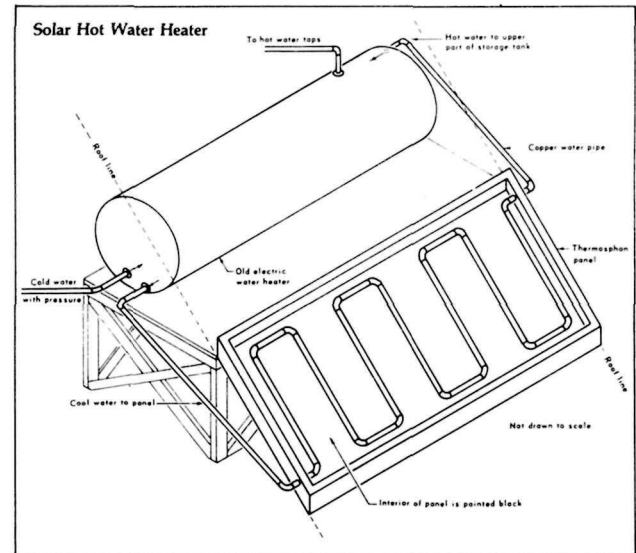
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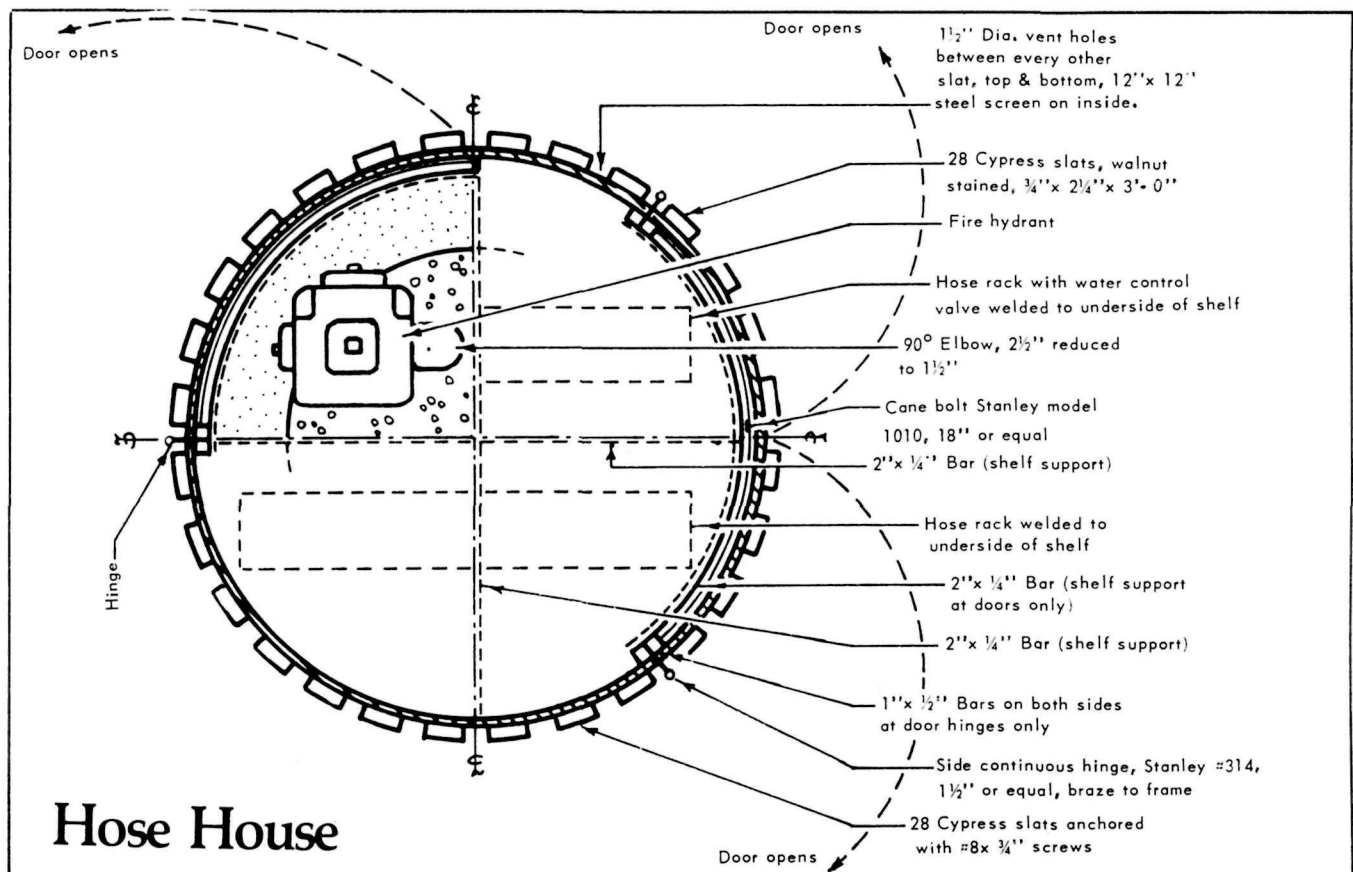
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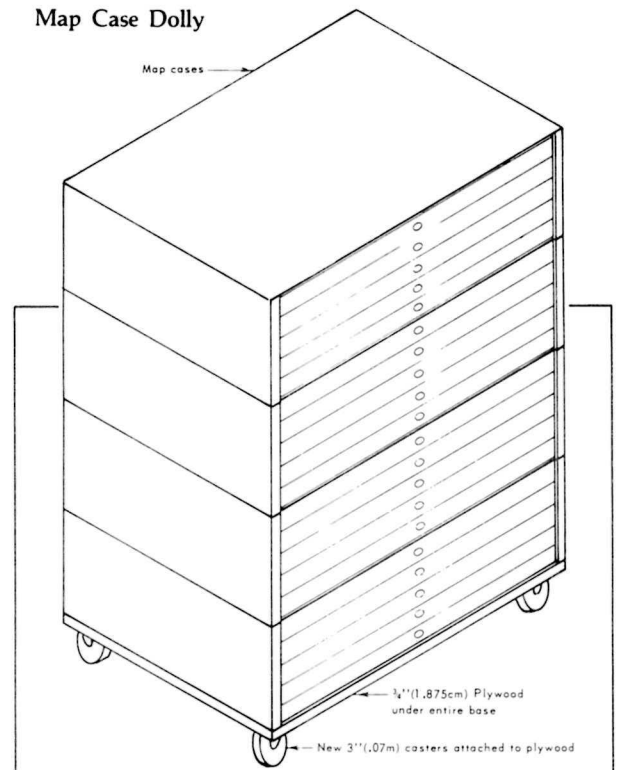
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Cris Jorgensen's early-1900 watercolor recorded the open, cathedral-like Mariposa Grove as it first appeared to modern man. . .
