COMMON VISITOR MISTAKES

1. Watching the scenery and tripping, slipping, sliding and stepping in the wrong place.

WATCH YOUR STEP

2. Peering at the scenery and hitting roadside barrier stones, bicycles, people and cars.

WATCH THE ROAD

3. Gazing at the scenery and getting separated.

WATCH YOUR CHILDREN

4. Checking the scenery and not the speedometer.

WATCH YOUR SPEED

5. Handling the scenery and getting poison ivy.

LEAFLETS THREE – LET IT BE

6. Feeding the scenery. Blackflies & mosquitoes enjoy park visitors.

WEAR APPROPRIATE CLOTHING AND REPELLANT

7. Camping on the scenery and displeasing the park rangers.

CAMP ONLY IN DESIGNATED CAMP GROUNDS

8. Climbing on and falling off the scenery.

THIS REALLY HURTS

9. Burning the scenery with smokes and campfires.

MAKE SURE IT'S OUT

10. Stealing some scenery for a souvenir.

TAKE PHOTOGRAPHS – NOT SCENERY

11. Leaving trash, bottles and paper in the scenery.

12. Getting ripped off by the unseen-ry.
