1759-1855

Ke-Che-Waish-Ke (Great Buffalo) represented the Ojibwe people during treaty negotiations with the federal government in 1825, 1837, 1842, and 1854. The elderly and well respected chief traveled to Washington and persuaded the government to reverse the Indian removal order of 1850.
