

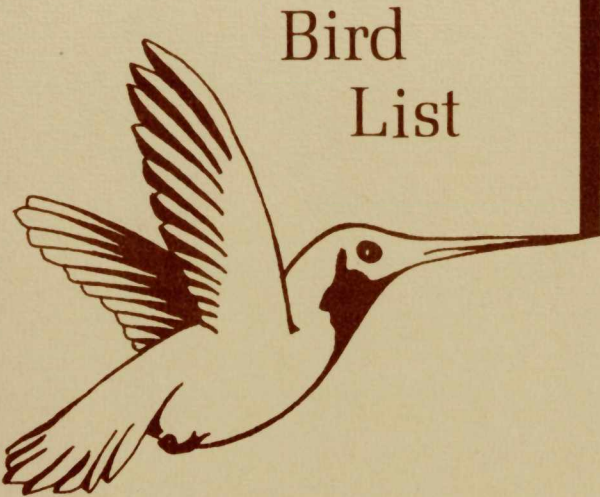

Bird List

This list contains the names and records of 181 species of birds recorded in Arches National Park. The area covered includes all of the Park plus the Colorado River where it forms the border of the Park, from the mouth of Salt Wash (mile 11 on Utah 128) downstream to the US 191 bridge (mile 0), and lands or waters immediately adjacent to the Park.

The list is compiled from observation records maintained by the Park and judged as accurate. All observation records are kept in the Park's files; most records are from the past 20 years and the majority were made by Park personnel.

This listing was originally compiled by Sartor O. Williams III, PhD. Careful observers are encouraged to submit detailed records of any presently unreported species, of any species presently considered uncommon, rare, or occasional, and of any species outside the known dates of its occurrence. Any specific information detailing nesting, even of common species, is welcomed.

RELATIVE ABUNDANCE

C = Common: occurs regularly, often in numbers; easily found in proper season and habitat.

U = Uncommon: occurs more or less regularly, but generally in small numbers; usually found in proper season and habitat.

R = Rare: 3 to 6 records total; unusual, but to be looked for each year; may be more common than the few records indicate.

O = Occasional: 1 or 2 records total; highly unusual, but not necessarily out of range; to be expected again.

A = Accidental: 1 record only; out of range; not to be expected again.

* = Recorded on lands or waters immediately adjacent to the Park boundary; usually within ½ mile of the Park, but as yet unrecorded within the Park.

! = Federally Endangered Species.

BREEDING STATUS

• = Definitely known to breed in the Park area, based on observation of nest building, nests with eggs, young in nests, or adults with dependent, very recently fledged young.

° = Probably breeds, based on presence of adults throughout the usual nesting season, often singing and/or defending territories but firm evidence of nesting is lacking.
