PARKING AT BANDELIER

During heavy visitation periods, parking areas in the Visitor Center/Ruins Trail area fill to capacity and you may have to wait for a parking space to become available.

NOTE:

Parking for oversized vehicles is extremely limited in the Frijoles Canyon/Visitor Center area and during busy times may not be available at all. Please comply with the following <u>Parking</u> <u>Regulations</u>:

- ⇒ Abide by all posted signs, pavement markings and barricades (whether natural or man-made) that delineate "No Parking" areas.
- \Rightarrow Do not park anywhere along the Entrance Road.
- ⇒ Do not use any more space than necessary to safely park your vehicle so that there will be room for others.
- ⇒ Parking in Main Lot is restricted to vehicles 17 feet or under, including any attachments such as racks, spare tire, etc.
- ⇒ Vehicles between 17 and 20 feet in length may park in either the Backpackers Parking Lot or the Picnic Area, so as not to obstruct traffic.
- ⇒ All private vehicles over 20 feet long must park only in areas shown on the Map (over) as RV Parking spaces.
- \Rightarrow All non-private buses must provide a driver in addition to tour guide/group leader and are required to park in the Amphitheater lot.
- ⇒ Trailers and towed vehicles are prohibited in Frijoles Canyon. They must be left at the Amphitheater Parking Lot near Juniper Campground.
- ⇒ The use of generators in Frijoles Canyon is prohibited at all times.

Failure to comply with any of these regulations may result in a fine.
