A wide pattern of striking scenery unfolds in varied panoramas as you travel the Parkway. Superb mountain scenery and the pleasant climate have influenced the popularity of the Blue Ridge Parkway as a vacation area.

The Blue Ridge Parkway has opened new scenic vistas in eastern America. The parkway traverses the highlands of Virginia and North Carolina at an average elevation of 3,000 feet and extends from Shenandoah National Park, Virginia to Great Smoky Mountains National Park, North Carolina and Tennessee.

The spring season arrives with the flowering dogwood — followed by colorful flame azaleas, rhododendron and mountain laurel. Autumn flames brilliant with the reds of sumac, gums and maples; and the bright yellow hues of the sassafras, tulip tree and hickory.

Picturesque log cabins, miles of rail fences and rustic Mabry Mill emphasize the pioneer culture of the Blue Ridge Highlands. Mabry Mill, located in southern Virginia. The Parkway shops offer a variety of colorful mountain handicrafts which include pottery, weaving, woodcraft and metalcrafts.

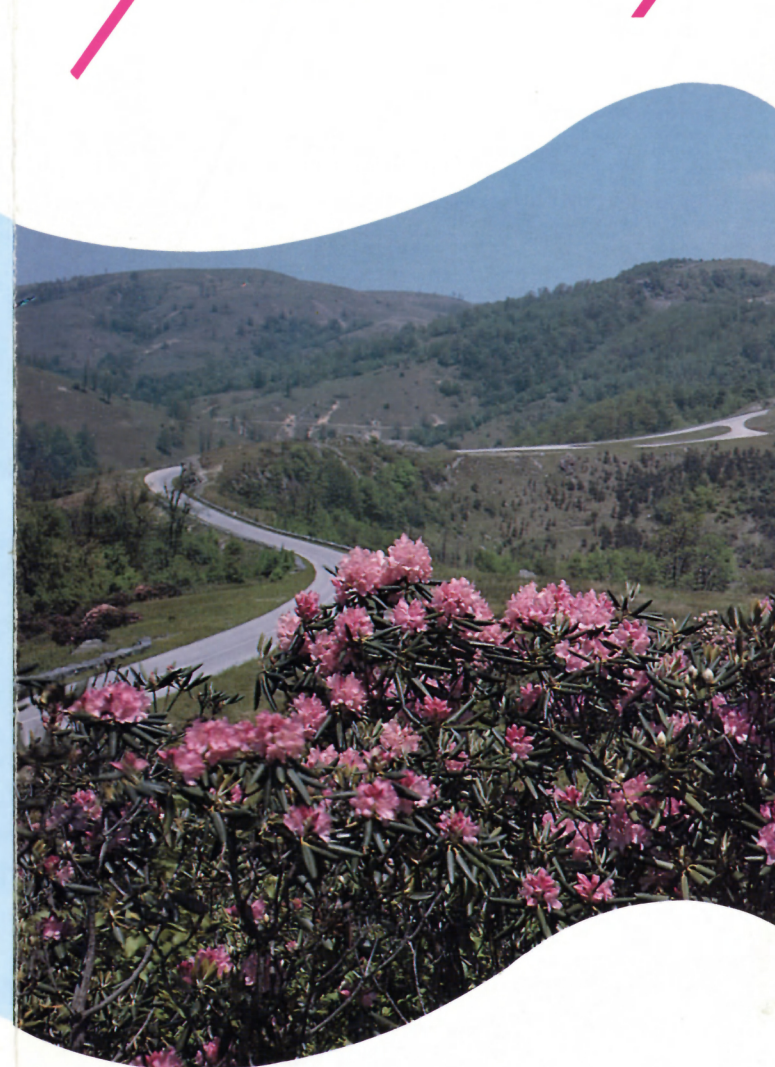

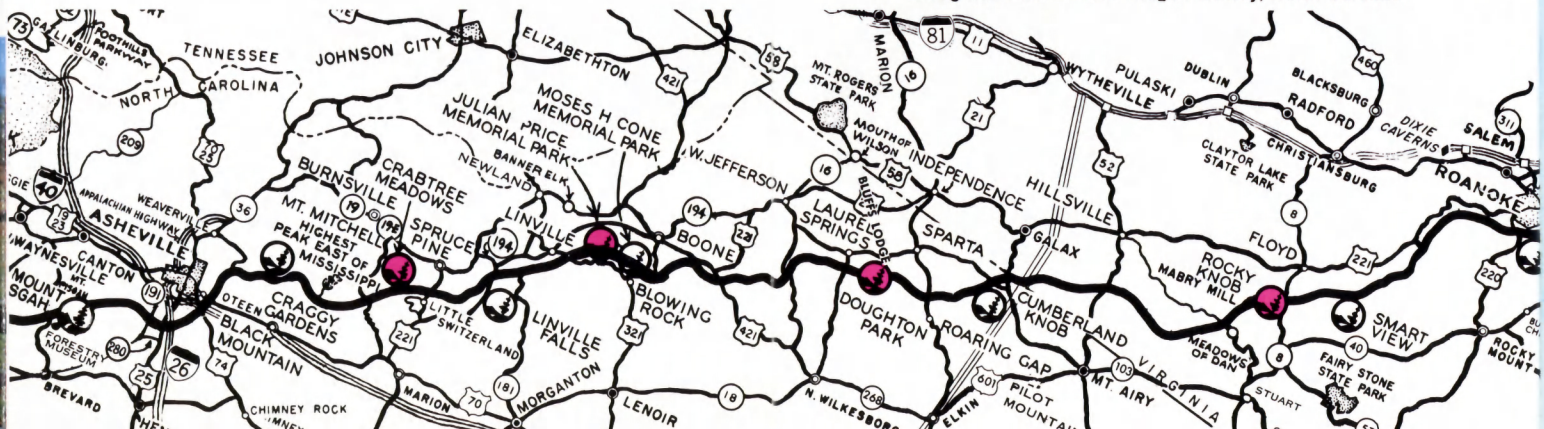
