In June 1864, Confederate General Nathan Bedford Forrest threatened critical Union supply lines in Tennessee. Federal troops were sent to stop him. The resulting battle was a brilliant victory for Forrest, but it came at a cost to the Confederacy. It is a great example of winning the battle, but losing the war.
