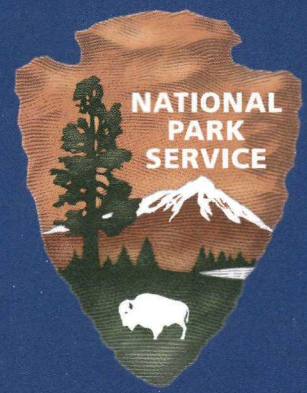

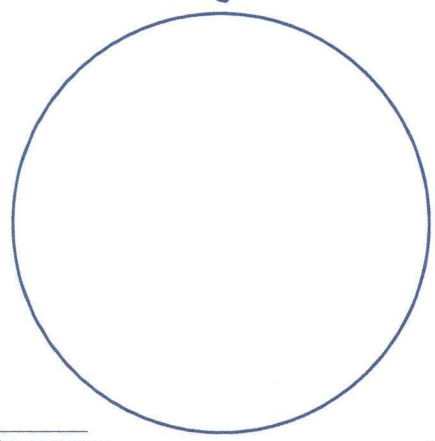

Know where you can go. Pets are not allowed on designated lifeguard beaches or in buildings.

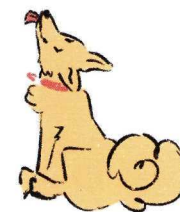
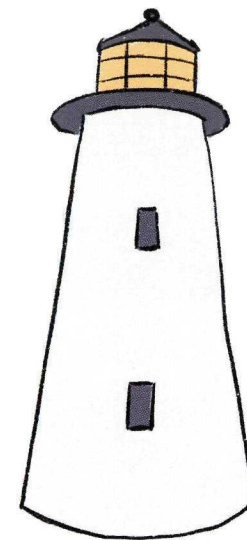
With over 70 miles of beach and many historical sites, use these B.A.R.K. Ranger principles while visiting Cape Hatteras National Seashore!

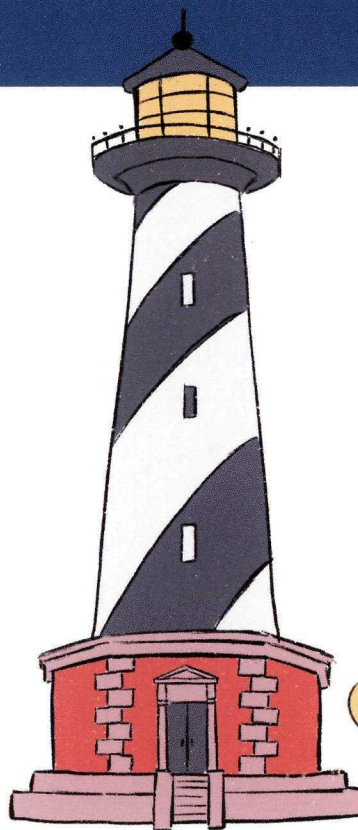


BODIE ISLAND
