### Eastern Tiger Swallowtail *Papilio glaucus*

This checklist is for those visitors who take the time to stroll along the rivers edge, over the hills that make the valley, and the flood plains in between in search of butterflies. When used with a field guide for identification, this checklist will serve as a valuable tool in keeping track of your sightings. Use the space to the right of the names to record the date when you first observe that species.

This checklist is a work in progress, listing those species which we believe you may find in the Chattahoochee River National Recreation Area. Many of these species have been observed in the park and are noted by an asterisk "\*".
