A lone cannon from a Confederate battery overlooking Chattanooga stands vigilant over the Tennessee River and the Chattanooga Valley. From this position, Confederate artillerymen held the Union troops under siege for two months, only to be driven from their position by Gen. Hooker in November 1863, during the "Battle Above The Clouds."
