During the Civil War over 40,000 Tennesseans served in the Union Armies. Because the area had few slaves, most people living in the Eastern Mountains of Tennessee, opposed leaving the Union. During the Battle of Chickamauga the 1st and 2nd Tennessee Union Cavalry Regiments fought their fellow Tennesseans serving in the Confederate Army.
