



Missing Soldiers

Fact Clara Barton raised the flag at the dedication of the Andersonville National Cemetery on Aug 17, 1865.

Between 1865 and 1869, Clara Barton responded to 63,182 requests for information from the families of missing Civil War soldiers; she located information for over 22,000. She also identified the graves of over 12.000 soldiers who died at Andersonville Prison in Georgia, and was responsible for the establishment of Andersonville National Cemetery.
