The Exhibit Building is open daily. Nearby, the Sinnott Memorial Overlook features hourly geologic talks and provides exceptional views of geologic formations within the caldera rim. There are a range of exciting hikes, from short walks to extended trips for the advanced hiker.

One of the Earth's greatest eruptions occurred here causing Mt. Mazama to collapse, forming a caldera in which one of the world's most beautiful lakes exists today. The lake, with 21 miles of surface, is surrounded by walls towering 500 to 2,000 feet above the water, accented by rugged peaks. Wizard Island and the Phantom Ship add beauty and interest to the park, along with bear, elk and numerous other small animals. Rainbow trout and Kokanee salmon are found in the lake.

Easy and Scenic Access

Excellent highways lead to the lake. Main Highway 62 from Medford and Highway 97 leading into Highway 62 from Klamath Falls, are open year 'round. Winter Coffee Shop: Light lunches, film, gifts, etc., are available during the off season. Lodging is available from June 15 to September 10.

At Rim Village is the Lodge, a handsome shingle and stone structure relating harmoniously with its natural surroundings. Within is a spacious lobby, big fireplace, rustic cocktail bar and main dining room. Excellent food is also available in pleasant surroundings at the Cafeteria. The Watchman Restaurant and Lounge, in the Cafeteria Building, has food and cocktails and a thrilling view of the lake.
