

Crater Lake Lodge

Grand Reopening-1995

Background:

Crater Lake Lodge originally opened to the public in 1915. The lodge served the public through the 1988 summer season. The National Park Service (NPS) has rehabilitated the lodge, preserving its historic character but adding many modern amenities.

Location:

The lodge is located on the rim of the Crater Lake caldera at an elevation of 7000 ft. on the south side of the lake at Rim Village. The lodge is reached via Highway 62 to the south park entrance from Klamath Falls and Medford or via Highway 138 to the north park entrance from Bend and Roseburg. Early and late season, the north entrance may be closed due to snow.

Season:

May 20, 1995 through October 14, 1995

May 18, 1996 through October 19, 1996

Rooms:

- 71 guest rooms; 63 with full bath and shower and 8 with claw bathtubs without showers.
- Guest rooms are uniquely designed to fit within the footprint of the original building, and provide spectacular views of Crater Lake and/or the upper Klamath Lake basin.
- All rooms have one or two queen-size beds.
- Commercial television and in-room telephones are not available.
- Handicap accessible guest rooms available.

Dining:

Crater Lake Lodge offers a fine dining experience in a 1930's style lodge decor, with spectacular views of the lake and upper Klamath River basin. Reservations are required.

A family style restaurant, the Watchman Eatery and Lounge, and the Llao Rock Cafe, a cafeteria, are located at Rim Village.

Room Rates:

- Single or double occupancy rates range from \$99.00 to \$119.00.
- Rooms with lofts and two queen beds are \$169.00 for up to four people. Additional people are \$10.00 each.

- Rates are regulated by the National Park Service and are subject to change.
- 6% county tax (subject to change)
- No pets.
- Check-in time 4:00 p.m., with an 11:00 a.m. checkout time.
- Advance deposit equal to one night's stay must be received within 14 days of booking a reservation. Credit cards are accepted and will be charged at the time of booking to secure reservation. Proper prepayment assures that room reservations will be held throughout the day of arrival regardless of the guests' arrival time.
- A 48 hour written notice of cancellation is required for refund of deposit, less a \$5.00 processing fee. Individuals cancelling a reservation will be provided a cancellation code.

Reservations:

Reservations will be taken starting November 7, 1994 for the 1995 and 1996 seasons.

Mazama Village Motor Inn

Located in a tranquil high mountain forest setting in the park, seven miles from the lodge, ten modern cabins, each with four guest rooms.

Season:

May 20, 1995 through October 14, 1995
May 18, 1996 through October 19, 1996

Rates:

- Rates range from \$59.00 during shoulder season to \$74.00 during peak season, single or double occupancy.
- Each guest room has one or two queen-size beds with bathroom and shower.
- Handicap accessible rooms available.
- The Mazama area includes Mazama Village Motor Inn, Mazama Village Campground (198 sites), convenience store with public showers and laundry, and gasoline.
