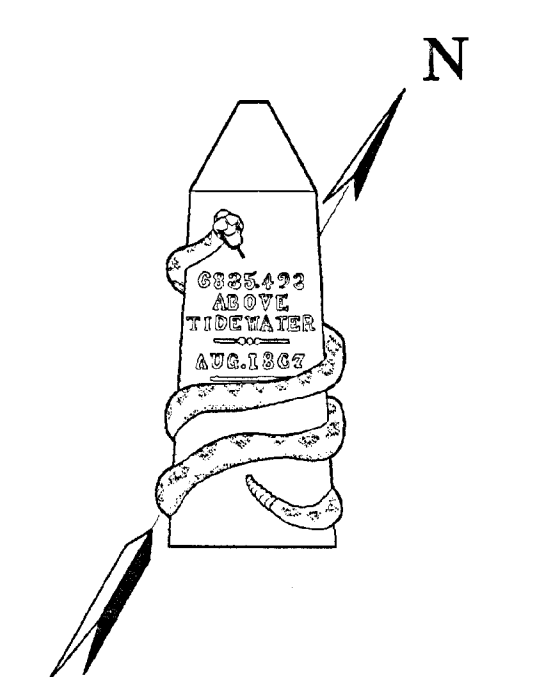
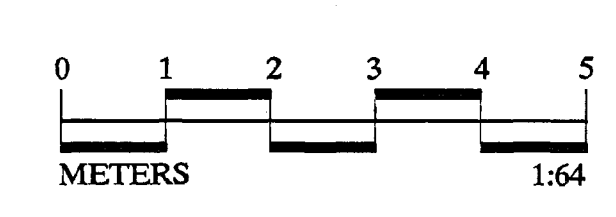
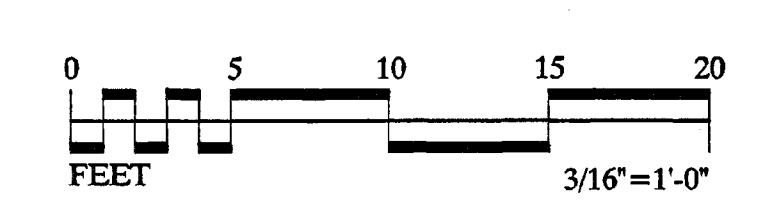
FORT UNION

THE QUARTERMASTER STOREHOUSE WAS CONSTRUCTED 1866-67. IN PLAN IT WAS DIVIDED INTO NINE SMALL ROOMS, FOR THE STORAGE AND DISBURSEMENT OF SMALL ITEMS SUCH AS TOOLS, HARDWARE, AND EQUESTRIAN EQUIPMENT.
