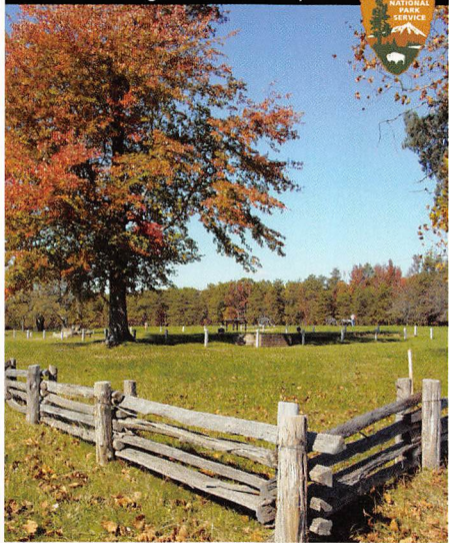

Chancellorsville Battlefield

Built: circa 1816

The Battle of Chancellorsville took its name from this large brick dwelling built by the Chancellor family. Union commander General Joseph Hooker made the house his headquarters until the third day of the battle, when Confederate artillery shells set it on fire. Many wounded soldiers being treated inside the house perished in the flames. Today only the foundation remains.
