## **Death of Jackson**The Battle of Chancellorsville Date: May 10, 1863

One of the greatest disasters to befall the South was the death of General "Stonewall" Jackson, who was mistakenly shot by his own troops at the Battle of Chancellorsville. Doctors treated Jackson at Thomas Chandler's home, "Fairfield," located at Guinea Station, Virginia. Eight days after his wounding, Jackson died. The last words he spoke were: "Let us cross
