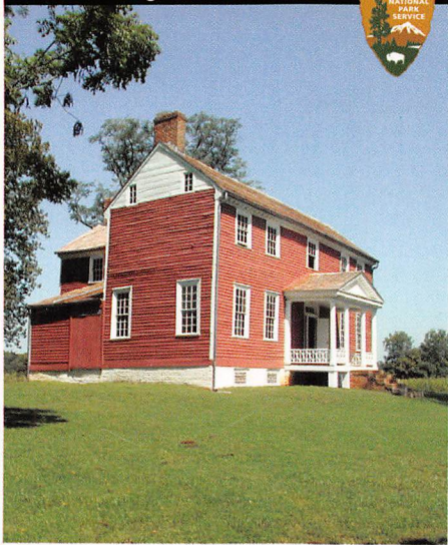

## **Ellwood** *The Wilderness*

Constructed: circa 1790

Ellwood played a prominent role in the Civil War. General Lee camped at the house on his way to Gettysburg in 1863, and two Union corps commanders made their headquarters at the house the following year during the Battle of the Wilderness. Today Ellwood is most famous as the burial place of “Stonewall” Jackson’s left arm, which is in the family cemetery, two hundred yards from the house.
