Fairview Battle of Chancellorsville Date: May 3, 1863

The Battle of Chancellorsville did not end with "Stonewall" Jackson's flank attack on May 2, 1863.

The next day the two sides again locked in five hours of savage battle. Seventeen thousand men would die or fall wounded that morning. The heaviest fighting took place around Fairview, a clearing on which the Army of the Potomac had posted more than 30 cannons.
