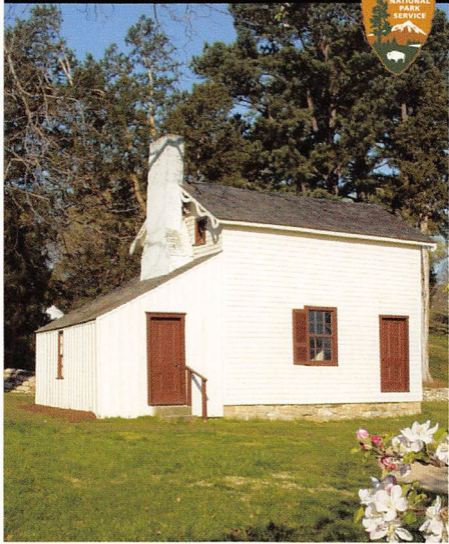

Date of Battle: December 13, 1862

Most white Southerners did not own large plantations. Most lived in modest houses, like the Innis house on Fredericksburg's famous Sunken Road. During the 1862 battle, South Carolina riflemen occupied the dwelling. The scars from dozens of bullets are still visible inside.
