

## **McCoull House**



The fighting at Spotsylvania Court House swirled around the house of farmer Neil McCoull. After the war, the remains of more than 1,300 Union soldiers were removed from McCoull's farm and carried to Fredericksburg for interment in Fredericksburg National Cemetery. The remains of Confederate soldiers, like those shown in this picture, were buried at a private cemetery near the battlefield.
