Confederate Soldiers from the Old North State

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While Virginia furnished the most men to the Confederate Army of Northern Virginia at Gettysburg, North Carolina contributed the second most. Of the more than fourteen thousand soldiers from North Carolina who fought in the Battle of Gettysburg, approximately 6,000 were included among the battle's killed, wounded, or captured, a 40% loss. Dedicated in 1929 and located at Auto Tour Stop #4, the State of North Carolina Monument was sculpted by Gutzon Borglum, who also sculpted Mount Rushmore.
