

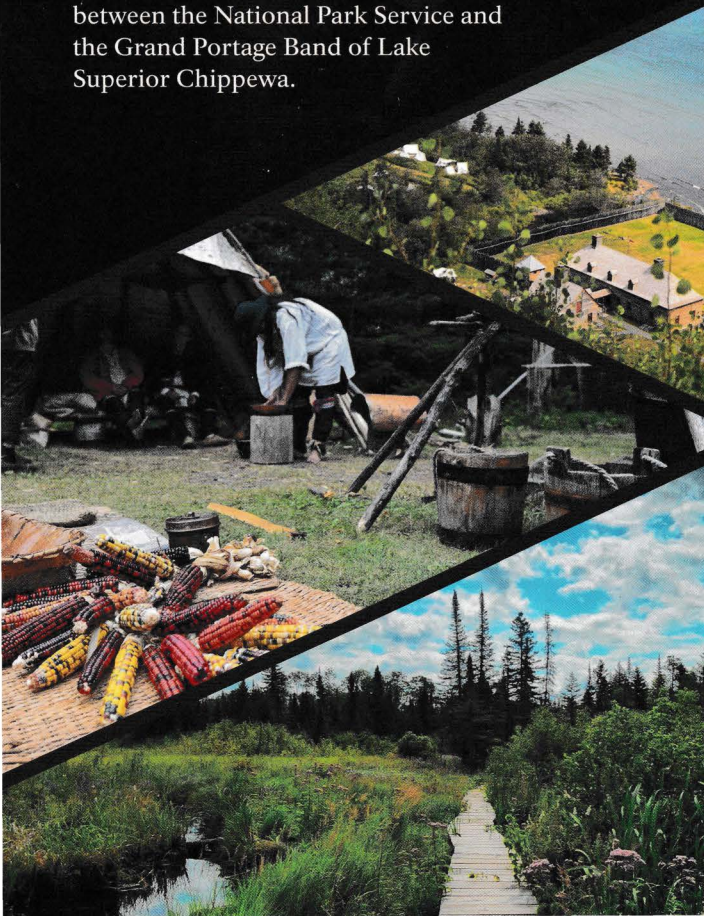

The historic depot is open Memorial Day weekend - Indigenous People's Day.

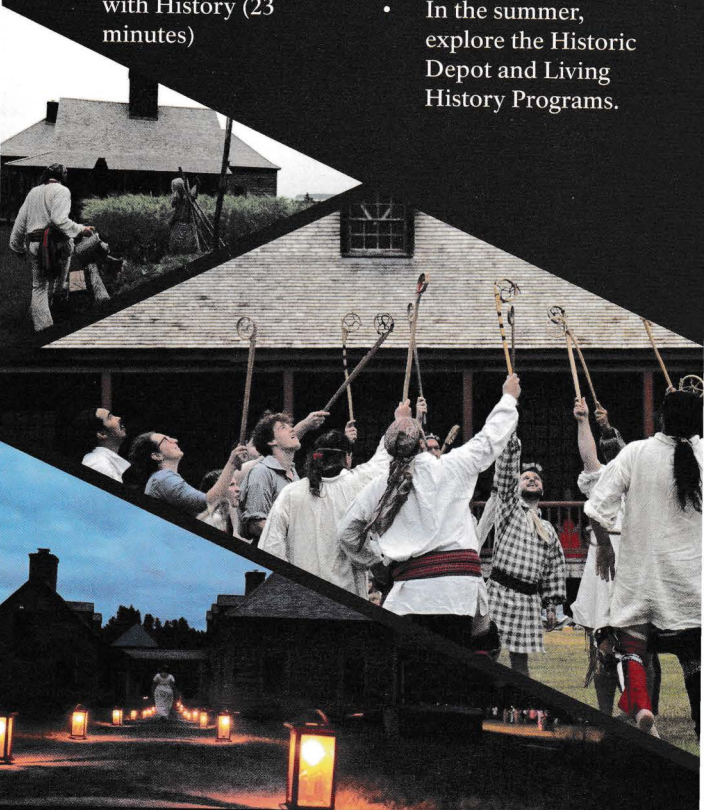
The Heritage Center is open year-round.
