APPENDIX W

### THE LIBRARY OF BISHOP WHITE

That Bishop White possessed a library of more than ordinary importance and size is evident from the portion which has survived, from documentary records, and from the 1836 painting of his study by John Sartain.

Since the Bishop's estate was not inventoried, we do not know just how many volumes his library contained. However, close study of the Sartain painting suggests that it contained at least one thousand volumes. Of these approximately one-third can be accounted for either by surviving copies or through documentary references.

What sorts of books did the Bishop own? As one would expect, his collection was especially rich in theological works. Almost all the books which have been located are of this character. However, a few extant volumes and others referred to in documents indicate that White had other interests as well, including history, literature, various philanthropies and commercial enterprises, the writings of such friends as Benjamin Rush and Joseph Priestley, and the publications edited by his son-in-law Enos Bronson.

Independence National Historical Park is fortunate to have, as a nucleus around which to reconstruct the Bishop's private library, almost two hundred volumes which once rested on the Bishop's shelves and bear his autograph. One of these was purchased, two have been donated by a descendant, and the balance are on permanent loan from the Divinity School of Philadelphia. To this nucleus it is hoped to add other volumes actually

owned by Bishop White. However, it will be necessary to supplement the collection with non-associated volumes. These will include titles known to have been owned by the Bishop, as well as titles which he might have owned. Choices in the last-mentioned category will be based on the Bishop's known interests and those of other members of his household, including two generations of children.

APPENDIX X

Window Curtain suggestions for the  
Bishop White House.

---

It is imperative, both from a decorative and an interpretive standpoint, to restore, as nearly as possible, the form and fabric of eighteenth century window hangings in an eighteenth century historic house museum. Estate inventories frequently provide specific information about the kind of fabric used,<sup>1</sup> but they give us no indication of the form of the hanging itself.


For form we must turn to paintings, drawings, and prints of the period. An eighteenth century painting showing a Philadelphia interior complete with curtains has not yet been seen by the writer. There are, of course, many portraits of Philadelphians by Philadelphia artists which show a flamboyant draping in the background; but this is an artistic device copied by the artist from prints of English portraits and have nothing to do with actual window hangings.

American drawings of window curtains with instructions for making them, are also very rare. Survivals of this nature, however, can be found in the papers of Thomas Jefferson.<sup>2</sup>

Illustrations #65-67 show the drawings (c.1798-1808) sent by Jefferson to John Rea, Philadelphia upholsterer and curtain maker. These were accompanied by detailed instructions for making curtains to be used at Monticello.<sup>3</sup> Jefferson requested only a valance or "drapery for the tops of 4 windows (no curtains being desired) somewhat in the style here drawn of crimson damask silk, lined with green

and a yellow fringe. In the House of Representatives are two small prints with drapery in this style which will give a just idea of what is desired."<sup>4</sup> These sketches also show John Rea's finished drawings. As they depict curtains of the proper date and locale, they could be most appropriately utilized as a design source for curtains in the Bishop White House.




Finished drawing of a curtain valance, made c.1798 by John Rea, Philadelphia upholsterer and curtain maker, for Thomas Jefferson.

Inset: Jefferson's original sketch sent to John Rea, inspired by the curtains he had seen at Congress Hall.



The red toile de Jouy which Jefferson brought with him from France appears to have been used in the bed rooms of the mezzanine story, if we may judge by some very minute calculations made during the years 1804-05. As remodelled, they made eight pairs of window curtains and three pairs for the alcove beds. These, too, have been put back, partly in antique fabric, partly in modern reproduction.
