

White-nose Syndrome: The Deadly Invader



White-nose Syndrome (WNS) is a disease responsible for the death of millions of bats in the US and Canada since 2006. The disease is caused by a white, powdery fungus that grows on the affected bat's nose, ears, and wing membranes.

Evidence suggests that the fungus (*Pseudogymnoascus destructans*) was introduced to the US from Europe via a human vector.

Your help is needed to prevent this fungus from infecting bats at Lava Beds.
