Small buildings of logs, wood frame, boulders, and cut stone, with boulder chimneys and generally rustic appearance. Most probably built by Park after park established 1916 around Lassen Peak, volcano which erupted between 1914 and 1921..

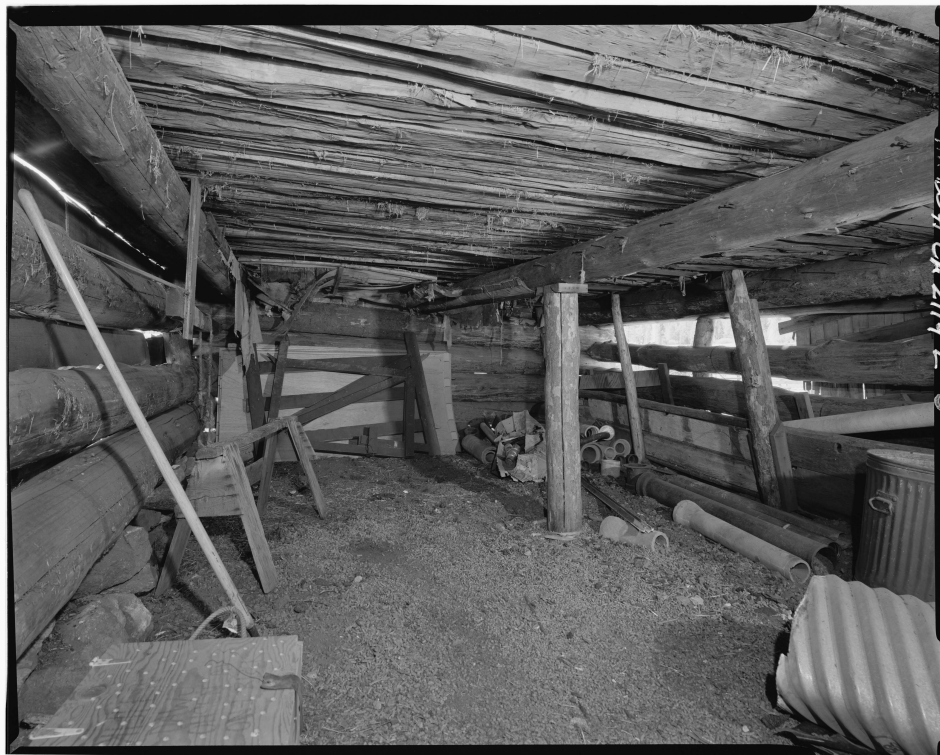

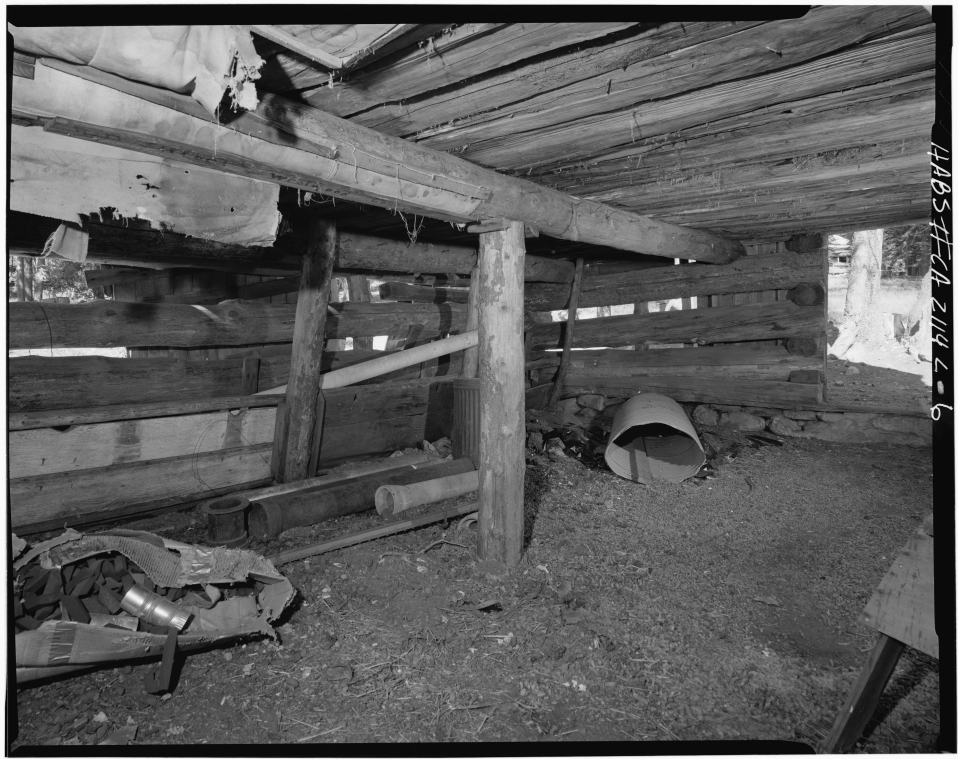
