Lincoln Living Historical Farm



The Lincoln Living Historical Farm is a working pioneer homestead with a log cabin, outbuildings, split rail fences, livestock, gardens, and field crops. Rangers dressed in period clothing perform a variety of activities typical of daily life in the 1820s including farming, gardening, cooking, spinning and etc. The Living Historical Farm is open from mid-April through September. Visitors, however, are invited to visit and browse around the farm site during unstaffed hours.
