



LINDENWALD, IN KINDERHOOK, NEW YORK, WAS THE HOME OF MARTIN VAN BUREN FROM 1839 UNTIL 1862. VAN BUREN SERVED AS STATE SENATOR, U.S. SENATOR, U.S. SECRETARY OF STATE, AMBASSADOR TO THE COURT OF ST. JAMES, VICE PRESIDENT AND EIGHTH PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES. IN 1839, LOOKING BACK OVER HIS LONG POLITICAL CAREER TO HIS BEGINNINGS IN KINDERHOOK VAN BUREN PURCHASED LINDENWALD, THE MANSION ONCE OWNED BY HIS BOYHOOD FRIEND WILLIAM VAN NESS. IN 1849 VAN BUREN ENGAGED ARCHITECT RICHARD UPJOHN TO DESIGN MODIFICATIONS TO THE ORIGINAL HOUSE (BUILT IN 1797) THAT INCLUDED A NEW WING WITH A SIX STORY TOWER AND A NEW ENTRANCE PORCH.


AFTER VAN BUREN'S DEATH AT LINDENWALD IN 1862, THE PROPERTY CHANGED HANDS MANY TIMES. MARTIN VAN BUREN NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE WAS AUTHORIZED BY AN ACT OF CONGRESS IN 1974 AND IS ADMINISTERED BY THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE.

THIS PROJECT WAS SPONSORED BY THE NORTH ATLANTIC REGIONAL OFFICE OF THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE IN COOPERATION WITH THE HISTORIC AMERICAN BUILDINGS SURVEY. LINDENWALD WAS MEASURED AND DRAWN IN AUTUMN 1976 BY JACK SCHAFER (UNIVERSITY OF CINCINNATI) WORKING UNDER CONTRACT WITH THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE.







MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

between the

MARTIN VAN BUREN NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE

and the

**HISTORIC AMERICAN BUILDINGS SURVEY/
HISTORIC AMERICAN ENGINEERING RECORD**

NATIONAL PARK SERVICE

U.S. DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR

I. BACKGROUND

Under the authority of the 1935 Historic Sites Act and the 1966 National Historic Preservation Act, as amended in 1980, the Historic American Buildings Survey/Historic American Engineering Record (HABS/HAER) assists in the preservation of significant resources by recording historic buildings and structures and transmitting the documentation to an architectural and engineering archive at the Library of Congress. Documentation of resources by HABS/HAER provides baseline data which assists in directing planning efforts for rehabilitation and restoration, as well as historic structures reports and can facilitate in the interpretation of the buildings and grounds.

II. PURPOSE

The purpose of this document is to define an agreement between the Martin Van Buren National Historic Site and the Historic American Buildings Survey/Historic American Engineering Record (HABS/HAER) to cosponsor an HABS recording project of the Lindenwald (Martin Van Buren House).

III. PROJECT

The Historic American Buildings Survey/Historic American Engineering Record of the National Park Service and the Martin Van Buren National Historic Site will jointly sponsor an architectural documentation project during 1997 to produce field measurements, existing-condition measured drawings, and large-format photography as listed in Section IV, SCOPE OF WORK, of this Memorandum of Agreement. This project will contribute to completion of documentation undertaken by Northeast Regional Office in 1976 and the photographic documentation will join the six previous photographs by HABS in the Library of Congress and will be transmitted to the Library as an addendum to these earlier records.

IV. SCOPE OF WORK

HABS Washington, D.C. office will direct and conduct a 1997 documentation project at Lindenwald (Martin Van Buren House) in consultation with the Martin Van Buren National Historic Site.

The 1997 HABS recording team will produce architectural documentation consisting of field measurements, existing-condition measured drawings, large-format photography

Scope of Work (summarized):

Drawings: Completion of the 1976 set

The drawings from the incomplete 1976 by the Northeast Regional Office set will be edited, completed and finalized for transmittal the Library of Congress.

Drawings: Updated set with existing conditions:

The following list of drawings will be produced using the 1976 set as the base for the main house. Approximately 15 24 x 36 sheets will be completed. The plans, elevations, and sections will be drawn at 1/4" = 1'-0" the details will be drawn in larger scales as appropriate.

Main House (10 sheets)

- Basement plan
- First floor plan
- Second floor plan
- Third floor plan
- Tower and Main Roof plan
- East elevation
- South elevation
- West elevation
- North elevation
- Exterior entrance porch details

Gatehouse (5 sheets)

- Basement plan
- First floor plan
- Attic plan
- Roof plan
- East elevation
- South elevation
- West elevation
- North elevation
- Exterior details

Photography:

The HABS photographer will produce architectural documentation, consisting of large-format black and white photographs (negative 4" x 5" or larger). The photographic documentation can be accomplished with approximately 45 large-format views of the main house, gatehouse and site.

The Martin Van Buren National Historic Site will provide the photographer with the following:

- Parking space with close proximity to the site.
- Access to all structures, areas and spaces to be photographed.
- Electricity as required.
- Staff guidance and assistance as required.
- Telephone and utilities.
- Ladder, scaffolding, etc. as required.
- Safety and security briefing
- Secure space for equipment and supplies storage

HABS/HAER will provide the following:

- Photographic supplies.
- Photographic equipment.

The Martin Van Buren National Historic Site will assist the HABS field team in locating temporary inexpensive housing for the duration of the project and will provide the field team with the following:

- Access to all structures, areas and spaces to be documented.
- Air-conditioned office space.
- Telephone and utilities.
- One drafting table and stool per architectural team member.
- Ladders, scaffolding, etc. as required.
- Access to one IBM-compatible word processor and printer.
- Access to a photocopy machine.
- Access to papers and other records germane to the site being recorded.
- Safety and security briefing
- Secure space for equipment and supplies storage

HABS will provide Washington office supervisory personnel and measuring and drafting supplies.

V. TIME SCHEDULE

The HABS recording project will begin on or about June 2, 1997 and will extend for approximately twelve (12) weeks. The HABS staff photographer will be scheduled in accordance with the daylight and foliage conditions, and the overall project schedule.

VI. HABS RECORDING TEAM

The HABS Lindenwald documentation project will be undertaken by a professionally qualified team consisting of a project supervisor, two architecture technicians, and an HABS staff photographer. The recording team will be under the direct supervision of the HABS Washington, D.C. office. *Team members may be hired as Federal employees or*

private contractors, or be employed by outside organizations under cooperative agreements with HABS/HAER. Federal employees will be covered by all benefits provided to U.S. government temporary employees. Non-Federal employees will be accorded VIP status for liability purposes.

VII. FUNDING

The Martin Van Buren National Historic Site will transfer \$ 30,600.00 to the HABS, Washington, D.C. office by April 15, 1997, to cover the cost of field personnel, supplies, photography, travel, and reproductions.

The HABS Lindenwald documentation project funds can be utilized only on the Lindenwald Documentation project. Upon completion of the recording project, any of these funds not expended will be returned to the Martin Van Buren National Historic Site, unless HABS/HAER is directed otherwise.

VIII. RECORDS AND DELIVERABLES

Upon completion of the Washington office editing of the documentation produced on Lindenwald (Martin Van Buren House), The Martin Van Buren National Historic Site will be provided with:

- Full size Xerox on vellum copies of the measured drawings.
- 8-1/2" X 11" reduced Xerox copies of the measured drawings.
- One 8" x 10" black and white print of all views, identified and numbered.
- One Xerox copy on archival bond of the final edited written materials.

Within one year after the termination of the HABS Lindenwald documentation project, all original records produced by HABS will be transmitted to the HABS/HAER collection at the Library of Congress.

The Martin Van Buren National Historic Site will credit the National Park Service, HABS/HAER Division and the delineator, and/or photographer when drawings, photographs and/or written materials are published or exhibited.
