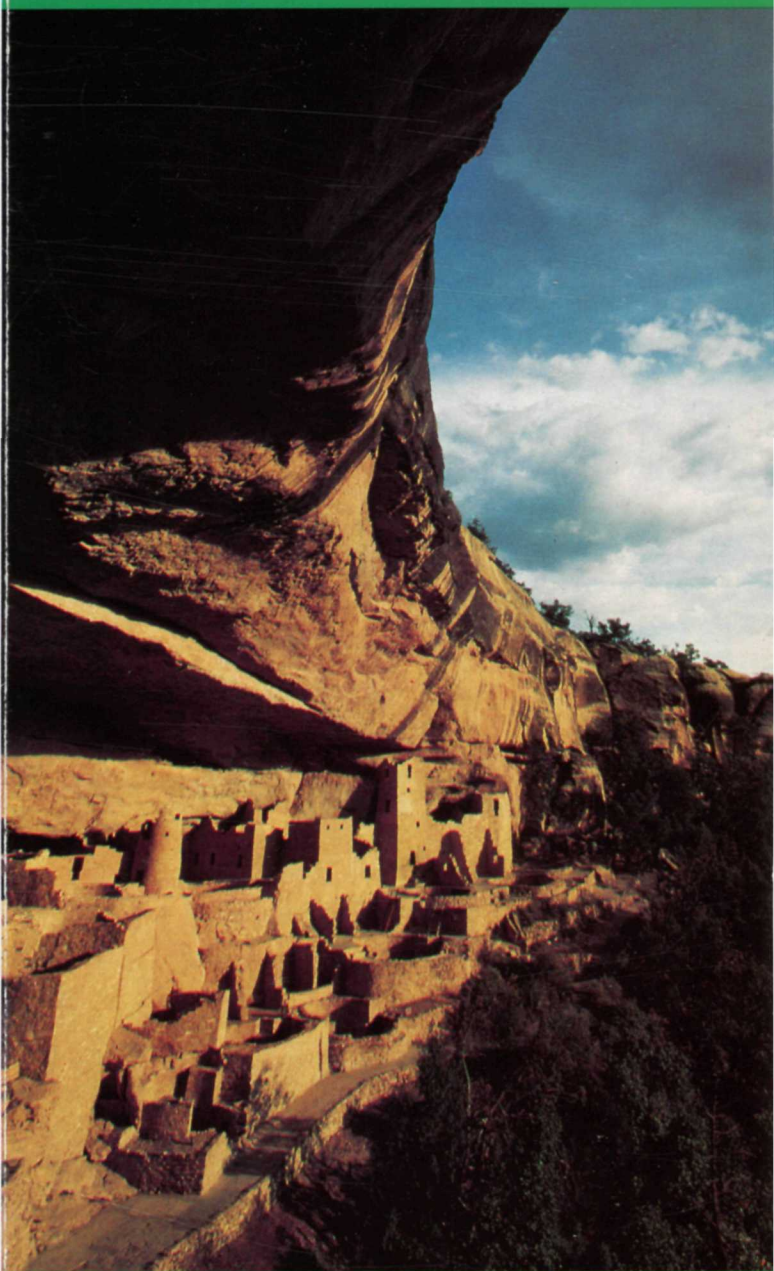

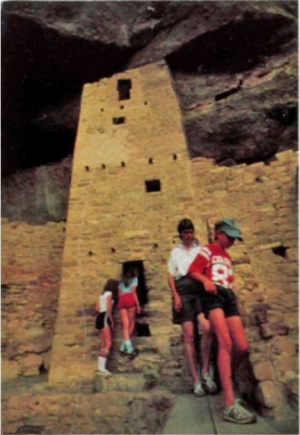

FAR VIEW LODGE



The only lodging inside the Park



Away from the traffic and noise of highways, Far View Lodge is the natural place to stay when visiting the Park.

After sightseeing and exploring the Cliff Dwellings on one of our special three hour tours, settle in for the evening and enjoy the spectacular view of three states from your own room's private balcony. Savor a Margarita from the bar's outdoor Terrace. Then enjoy a leisurely paced meal in our Dining Room, selecting from one of our Southwestern specialties. Later take in the Multi-Media show "Anasazi" or photograph a mule deer grazing on the Lodge grounds.

Far View Lodge is located on Navajo Hill, 15 miles inside the Park. Walk-ins are welcome.

MOREFIELD CAMPGROUND



Morefield Village Campground is located 4 miles inside Mesa Verde. Choose from over 450 well-landscaped campsites in this cool, green valley. At dusk you can join the other campers and a Park Ranger for a special campfire program in a natural outdoor amphitheater.

SPRUCE TREE TERRACE

Spruce Tree Terrace is located near the Archaeological Museum 19 miles within the Park. The Restaurant features croissants for breakfast and a variety of deluxe Western hamburgers for lunch, as well as an ice cream counter. Bike rentals offer a unique way to explore the Park. A lovely Native American hand-crafted gifts shop and a light convenience store are also available.
