George G. Meade Memorial

Location: Pennsylvania Ave. & 3rd Street, N.W. Dedicated: October 19, 1927

Maj. Gen. George Gordon Meade commanded the Union Army of the Potomac from just prior to its tremendous victory at Gettysburg in July 1863 until the end of the Civil War. Erected by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to the "Victor of Gettysburg," the memorial stands along the avenue where Meade led his victorious troops in the 1865 Grand Review of the Armies of the United States.
