



Ulysses S. Grant Memorial

Location: National Mall at 1st Street, N.W. **Dedicated:** April 27, 1922

Lieutenant General Grant astride his warhorse Cincinnatus is the central figure in this memorial, dedicated on the centennial of Grant's birth. The eyes of the general are fixed to the west, on the memorial to his commander-in-chief, Abraham Lincoln. The two memorials form the east and west boundaries of the National Mall, and in tandem act as sentinels who watch over the capital to this day.
